In light of the **Joint Order by the DENR**, **MGB and EMB MIMAROPA** issued on February 6, 2023 to Altai Philippines Mining Corporation due to their extraction/construction activities and the numerous notices of violation, including PD 705 otherwise known as the Revised Forestry Code for cutting trees and clearing/exploration without the required permit and/or certification, we demand that your office enforce this Joint Order with full force.

It has been a month since the Joint Order and we would like to follow-up on the status of the investigation conducted by PENRO Romblon and the inventory of trees cut and the amount of ores illegally extracted by Altai in its activities.

We hope, as concerned citizens of Sibuyan Island, to be part of the investigation team to ensure objectivity throughout the process.
