We invite your researchers once again to participate in this project by filling out this form (<http://bit.ly/GAD-AANR>) and using this form to submit their abstracts and papers.





## GUIDELINES

**Studies:**  
 In Agriculture, Aquatic, and Natural Resources (AANR) with a gender analysis (e.g. sex-disaggregated data, women empowerment, involvement in the decision-making process); include theses of graduates and students; or unpublished works; were completed from 2000 to 2022.

**Abstract should:**  
 Include introduction, methods, results and discussion, conclusion, and implications include maximum of 6 keywords; limit the number of words to 250; spell out all abbreviations the first time these are mentioned; and exclude citations.  
 A Google Survey Form needs to be answered prior to submission.
