

BAYATAO, BARANGAY TAGABINET, PUERTO PRINCESA
CITY, PALAWAN**

Respectfully forwarded is the memorandum dated May 10, 2023, of OIC-CENRO Pedro A. Velasco together with the spot report dated May 9, 2023, of MES personnel relative to the apprehension of 363 pcs. of Ipil and Amugis lumbers with an equivalent volume of 4,810 Bd.ft. of various sizes and dimensions in Sitio Bayatao, Barangay Tagabenit, Puerto Princesa City.

Please be informed that the said illegally cut/sliced lumbers were apprehended by the Barangay – Local Government Unit of Tagabinet and Tribal Leaders of Cabayugan and Tagabinet, Puerto Princesa City, without a permit and in violation of Section 77, Presidential Decree 705, known as the Forestry Code of the Philippines. Accordingly, the apprehending team caught a certain Eduardo Nitor and Rennie Boy Alla who were alleged to be both active members of Puerto Princesa Subterranean River Natural Park (PPSRNP), and Mr. Edgar Bardo, a resident of Brgy. Cabayugan in the act of slicing lumbers, using a chainsaw.

Be informed further that the hauling of the said apprehended lumbers is ongoing, jointly initiated by this office and CENRO Puerto Princesa City with the assistance of CADC members of Brgys. Tagabinet and Cabayugan. This office also created a fact-finding team to conduct an in-depth investigation on the matter in coordination with the City-Local Government Unit and the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD) staff. Rest assured that we will submit the corresponding report on the matter as soon as possible.

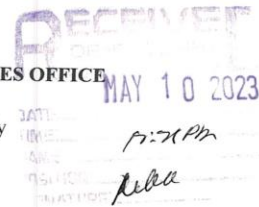

SUBJECT : **SPOT REPORT RE: APPREHENSION OF LUMBER AT SITIO BAYATAO, BARANGAY TAGABENIT, PUERTO PRINCESA CITY, PALAWAN.**

1. **WHAT:** Apprehension of Ipil and Amugis lumbers for violation of Section 77, P.D 705.
2. **WHO:** Eduardo Nitor, Rennie Boy Alla and Edgar Barbo
3. **WHEN:** May 7, 2023
4. **WHERE:** So. Bayatao, Barangay Tagabenit, Puerto Princesa City
5. **HOW:**

At around 5:30 PM of May 07, 2023, upon the instruction of Forester II Dennis Aldrin Velasco, OIC-Chief, Monitoring and Enforcement Section, we responded to the report from PB Juvylyl Bonda and Tribal leaders of Cabayugan and Tagabinet regarding on the apprehension that they made on the alleged illegal cutting/slicing of trees at Sitio Bayatao, Barangay Tagabenit, Puerto Princesa City involving certain individuals who were alleged to be an active member of PPSRNP.

FR Ryan Domondon and Raymund Sapalo together with Forest Protection Officers departed from Sta. Lourdes Monitoring Station around 5:30 in the afternoon onboard a dump truck that supposed to be used for hauling. The team arrived in the area around 6:40 in the evening but because of bad weather condition and several road blockades, the team were not able to locate the exact location of the cutting area. After an hour of trekking the team decided to withdraw and rescheduled the following day the supposed lumber retrieval.

The said apprehension on May 07, 2023, was undertaken by tribal leaders of Barangay Tagabinet, Cabayugan, and Barangay-LGU of Tagabenit led by Punong Barangay Juvylyl Bonda. According to PB Bonda, the said cutting/slicing of trees was not properly coordinated with the CADC members/tribal members and LGU-Barangay of Tagabenit, and no permit to cut from DENR. That they were able to caught in the act of slicing lumbers, using chainsaws, certain Eduardo Nitor and Rennie Boy Alla who were alleged to be both active members of Puerto Princesa Subterranean River Natural Park, and Mr. Edgar Barbo a resident of Brgy. Cabayugan.

Based on the information gathered from Mr. Nitor during a short interview conducted by FR Domondon, he alleged that he asked for permission from the head of PPSRNP, secured a Barangay Certification from Barangay Cabayugan, and FPIC from the CADC of Cabayugan. And that the said

sawn/sliced trees were already uprooted/felled due to typhoon Odette. He also claimed that he had already sawn more or less four thousand-board feet (4,000 bd. ft). According to one of the tribal leaders who participated in the apprehension, the chainsaws used in the cutting of trees were taken back by the owners identified as Mr. Greg and Ms. Lolita Asiong.

On May 8, 2023, Monitoring and Enforcement personnel led by Forester I Arjay Gregas and Neil James Verzosa team leader of Sta. Lourdes Monitoring Station conducted a follow-up investigation to assess the situation and plan the possible hauling of the apprehended lumbers. The team locate the cutting area and conducted the initial inventory, scaling, and documentation of the sliced/sawn lumbers.

Upon further inspection, we observed that there were three uprooted/felled trees sliced/sawn into flitches comprising two (2) Ipil and one (1) Amugis. Initial scaling/inventory disclosed that there is more or less 309 pcs of Ipil lumbers with estimated volume of 4,810 Bd.ft. and 54 pcs Amugis lumber with an equivalent volume of 590 bd.ft.

Based on our assessment, the only and fastest way of hauling the said lumbers to the nearest point area, where conveyance can penetrate or reach, is thru the employment of carabaos with a sled. Initial negotiations with PB Bonda and Tribal Leaders of Cabayugan and CADC were already undertaken. They commit to helping us find possible carabaos for rent with a rate of 10 pesos per board foot, the lowest possible price for hauling. We also observed that some of the flitches are too large and heavy that hauling using carabaos seems to be impossible, hence we asked for a legal opinion if slicing these lumbers into smaller pieces is possible.

Currently, the most needed logistics is the cash to fund the hauling of carabaos. It is also needed the expertise of a legal researcher to facilitate the deposition of possible witnesses or those involved in the apprehension.

Furthermore, the hauling of apprehended lumbers is ongoing with the monitoring and assistance of CENRO personnel, and CADC members of Bgy. Tagabenit and Cabayugan.

Given the foregoing, the undersigned recommends that an administrative adjudication be conducted according to DAO 97-32, and the filing of a criminal case if the evidence and circumstances warrant.

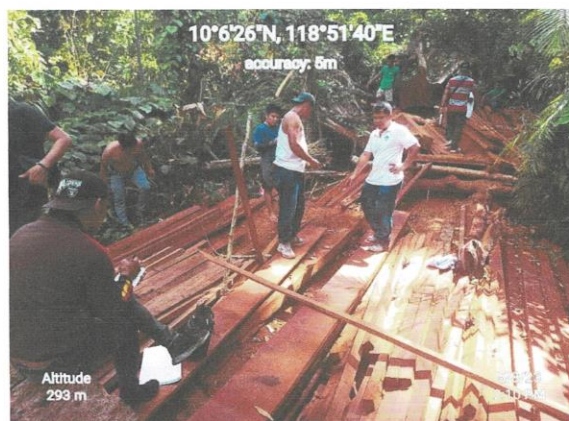
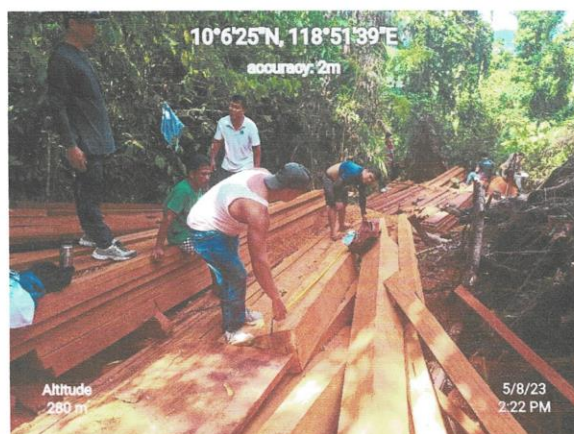
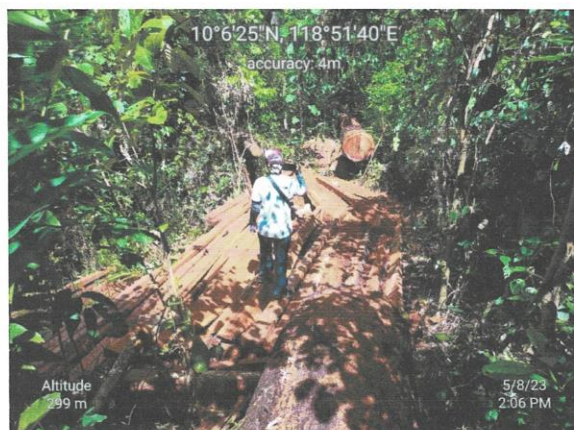
GEOTAGGED PHOTOS SHOWING THE APPREHENDED IPIL AND AMUGIS LUMBERS

PALAWAN





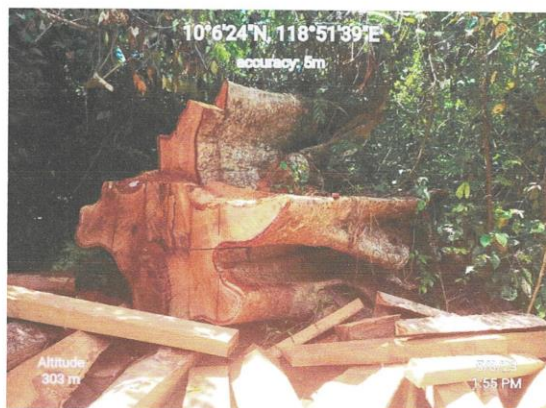
