To whom it may concern,

My name is Mike Collins and I am located in Palawan. The Palawan LGUs and DENR/PENRO were given 3 months to clean up the land of fallen trees from Typhoon Odette. Due to lack of equipment and manpower, 3 months was not long enough. But DENR Palawan has not been granted an extension to finish the job. Thus many trees are still fallen and need clean-up and now it has been over 1 year already.

I am trying to reach the head of DENR to request a donation of some of the trees that have fallen in the river here. In fact I am only requesting 3 trees. These trees have been inspected by DENR palawan and confirmed to be salvageable. However DENR did not send my application to Regional or Main for approval because they themselves have not been approved for cleaning up. So they gave me the application which I have attached to this email.

The rivers have trees that have fallen in them blocking the flow of the rivers and possibly being a hazard in the next flood. The rivers need to be cleaned up and I am requesting approval of the attached application in order to do my part in removing a few trees that DENR Palawan and PENRO have confirmed. We only need an approved permit from DENR MAIN to proceed. If possible, we would be greatly appreciative if this letter could be considered and forwarded to someone in authority that may consider our case and approve the request.
