The Committee on Ecology joint with the Committee on Natural Resources of the House of Representatives invites the Department to its public hearing on May 9, 2023, (Tuesday) 9:30am at the Macalintal Hall, South Wing Annex, House of Representatives to deliberate resolutions regarding the sinking of MT Princess Empress, the resulting oil spill, and accountability of sea carriers involved in maritime accidents as follows:
