This pertains with the Earth Day celebration, which is an annual event dedicated to raising awareness and inspiring action to tackle the various environmental challenges facing our planet. This day is also a time to celebrate those who have done a lot to help the environment. Earth Day is held on 22nd April each year, on this year it falls on Saturday with the theme *"Invest in our Planet"* which aims to persuade businesses, governments, and citizens around the world of the need to invest in our planet to improve our environment and give our future generations a better and safer environment.

In line with this celebration, the following activities were conducted, to wit:

1. The undersigned informed the co – employees during Office regular forum dated April 11, 2023, regarding the Month of Planet Earth and Earth Day, in which she reminded everyone on the ways to help the environment in simple ways, like to always bring a water tumbler in their daily errands so that they could avoid buying plastic water bottles and disposable cups for drinking.
2. This Office was invited as a resource person by the USAID for the Community Managed Savings and Credit Association (CoMSCA) training dated April 17, 2023 and ECOMS II Michelle J. Sebido was delegated by this Office to talk about the Role of Women in Watershed Management, likewise, she discussed the Earth day: How can we help to the Environment.
3. The undersigned discussed Earth Day and Climate Change during the Orientation/Meeting with the Certificate of Stewardship Contracts (CSCs) holders dated April 19, 2022 regarding the Policies on CSC renewal and cancellation and process of Evaluation and Assessment of the expired & expiring Certificate of Stewardship Contracts. A total of forty-nine (49) CSC holders were participated in, twenty - seven (27) male and twenty - two (22) female.
4. The Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) – Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary (RIWS) staff conducted coastal clean – up dated April 19, 2023 within the premises of Rasa Island, this is in commemoration with Month of Planet Earth. A total of ten (10) cement sacks of trash were collected and properly disposed.
5. The DENR – CENRO Quezon, in collaboration with the Berong Nickel Corporation (BNC) conducted a Coastal Clean – Up drive along the coastal area of Sitio Proper, Bgy. Berong, Quezon, Palawan and Tree Planting of Indigenous Species within the mined-out area of Berong Nickel Corporation (BNC). Prior the activities, the team facilitated a short program to inform the participants on what

event we are celebrating this month of April. The program started with a prayer given by Forest Extension Officer Norlan T. Gallardo, followed by the orientation on the Earth Day celebration that was given by the undersigned (emcee) and Inspirational Message from Chief, Conservation and Development Section (CDS) Michelle J. Sebido and MEPE Officer of BNC Jaypee Dela Cruz. Invited participants are BNC employees and staff, Bgy. Berong Officials and volunteers and some DENR – CENRO Quezon employees, a total of eighty-one (81) volunteers attended and participated in with a total of one thousand (1000) seedlings were planted, composed of different species of indigenous seedlings.

Please be informed that, upon receipt of Bgy. Berong of the letter from this Office regarding the coastal clean -up to be conducted for the celebration of Month of Planet Earth, the Officials together with some volunteers from the community conducted a clean – up within the proposed area prior to the said scheduled date. A total of five (5) sacks of trash only were collected during the coastal clean-up dated April 20, 2023. It is way lesser than the expected trash to be collected, it was because of the prior clean – up done by the officials and volunteers from the community.

These conducted activities were one of the many ways we can help combat the issue of marine debris, raise awareness on marine pollution, improve waste management and an action to inspire people on the desire for a cleaner, safer, and healthier and safer environment.

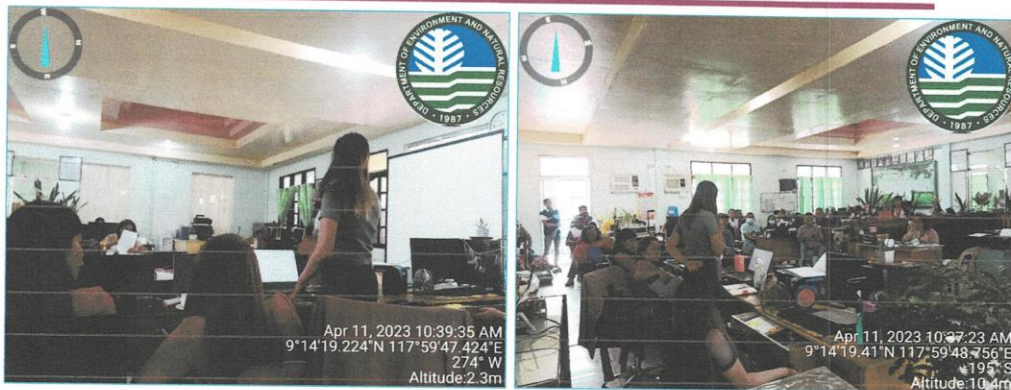

SUBJECT : **REPORT ON THE CONDUCT OF DIRECT ACTIVITIES IN RASA ISLAND WILDLIFE SANCTUARY FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL 2023**

This pertains to the quarterly direct activities/targets under the Coastal and Marine Ecosystems Rehabilitation Sub-Program for FY 2023.

Please be informed that the PAMO-RIWS personnel conducted coastal clean-up activity on April 19, 2023 at Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary. The activity was also in commemoration of the celebration of “The month of the planet earth” by virtue of Proclamation No. 1482 signed on April 10, 2008 by then President Gloria Macapagal – Arroyo.

During the conduct of the activity, a total of ten (10) cement sacks of garbage were collected with an estimated weight of approximately 34 kilograms. It was observed that most of the garbage collected were plastic bottles and old empty liquor bottles that were assumed to be either drifted by the tide/sea waves or allegedly brought by the claimants visiting the island.

The collected garbage was segregated and brought to the mainland for proper disposal.

Herewith the list of most collected waste/garbage in the area:

1. Plastic bottles
2. Liquor bottles
3. Slippers
4. Styrofoam Ice box (pieces)
5. Plastic wrappers
6. Old ropes
