

This refers to the application for appropriate tenurial instrument/agreement/permit of the Provincial Local Government Unit (PLGU) of Marinduque represented by Governor Presbitero J. Velasco, Jr. situated in Barangay Balogo, Sta. Cruz, Marinduque. The proposed area is the abandoned Balogo Port previously covered by an expired OLPLA No. 002 (Bodega and Port Facilities) which was granted on February 21, 1968 in favor of Marcopper Mining Corporation (MMC).

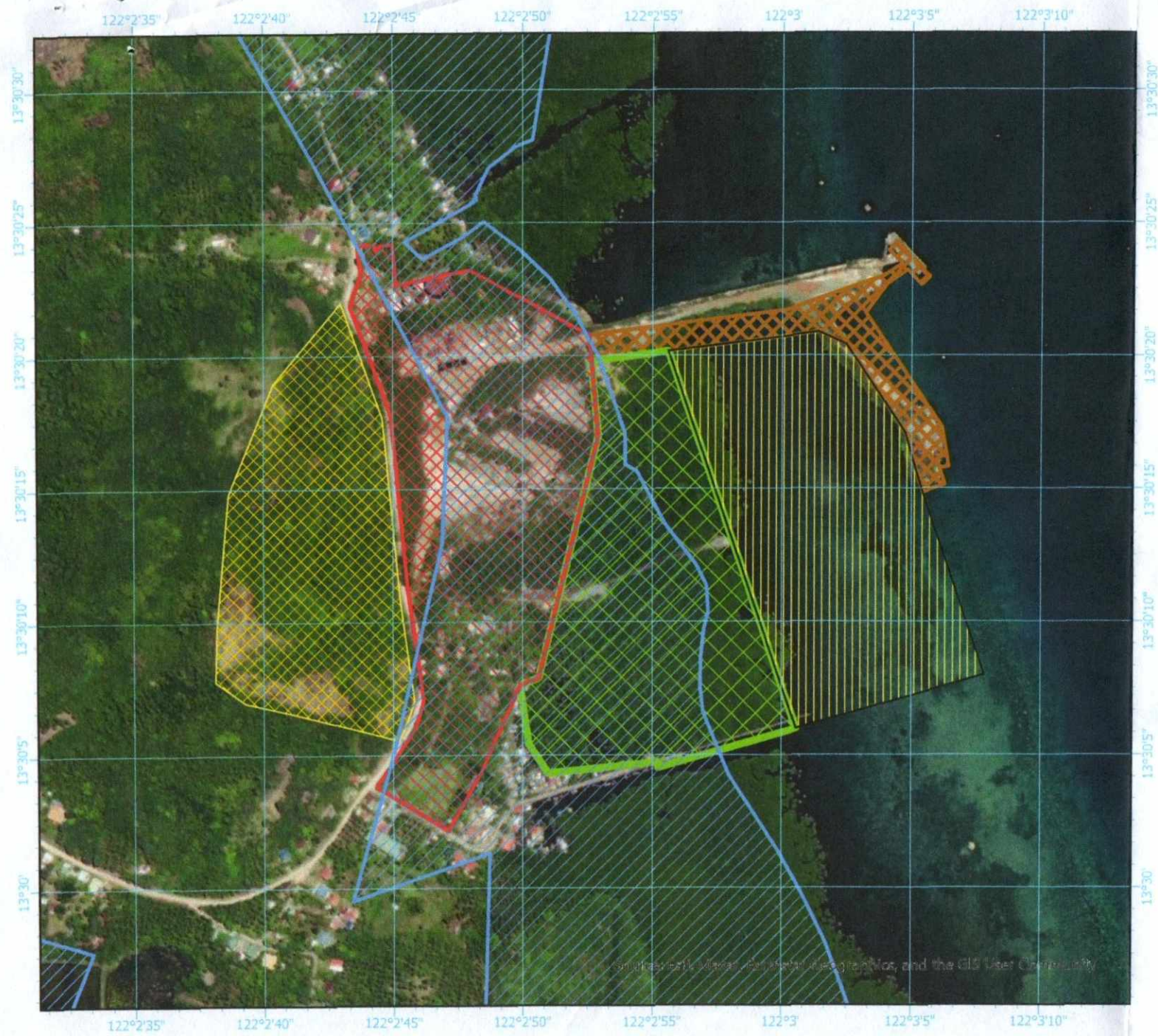
Based on the result of the ground assessment, inspection and validation conducted by the personnel of the Licenses, Patents and Deeds Division (LPDD) on April 18, 2023, it was found that portion of the applied site falls within Mangrove Swamp Forest Reserve pursuant to Presidential Proclamation 2152 dated December 29, 1981. *(please see attached map)*
