Currently, the PNP Maritime Group Headquarters is located in Camp BGen Rafael T Crame in Quezon City which has served us well for many years. However, due to the increasing demands and challenges on our mandates nationwide, it has become imperative to relocate and upgrade our facilities to better address these challenges.

In light of this, we are seeking your assistance and cooperation in identifying and providing a suitable parcel of land in Abra De Ilog for the strategic relocation of the PNP Maritime Group Headquarters. This relocation is not only crucial for the safety and well-being of our coastal communities but also for the effective enforcement of maritime laws, the prevention of illegal activities, and the promotion of marine conservation efforts in the country.

We believe that by working together, we can achieve our shared goals of improving security in our coastal areas, strengthening law enforcement efforts, and contributing to the preservation of our natural resources. We are committed to ensuring that any land allocated for this purpose will be used responsibly and with the utmost consideration for the environment


We would greatly appreciate the opportunity to discuss this matter further and explore potential options for the allocation of land. If you require any additional
