I. PRELIMINARIES

The meeting started at 2:20 in the afternoon, with an invocation and the

singing of the MIMAROPA Hymn.

II. BUSINESS PROPER

A. Declaration of Quorum

EnP. Sheryll B. Sarabia of NEDA MIMAROPA called the roll and declared a quorum. Of the 11 members, four were present and six were represented registering 91 percent attendance.

B. Welcome Remarks and Messages

Regional Development Council (RDC) Vice Chairperson and NEDA MIMAROPA Regional Director Agustin C. Mendoza called the meeting to order. He welcomed and thanked all the members and guests for attending the meeting.

C. Proposed Agenda

Oriental Mindoro Governor Humerlito A. Dolor requested to discuss the status of Commission of Population and Division (CPD) MIMAROPA and updates on the temporary usage of a portion of MIMAROPA Regional Government Center (RGC) site as storage facility for excavated materials before the other agenda items.

On motion duly seconded, the proposed agenda was approved as amended.

D. Approval of the minutes of the previous meeting

On motion duly seconded, the minutes of the second quarter RGCMC meeting was approved.

E. Secretary's Report

RGCMC Secretary EnP. Sarabia informed the members on the status of agreements forged during the previous meeting.

On the requests for lot allocation, the Committee approved the lot allocations of Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) MIMAROPA and National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) MIMAROPA in the MIMAROPA RGC with an estimated area ranging from 300 to 700 square meters per lot cut.

The lot area per regional government office (RGO) will be determined and provided in the MIMAROPA RGC Detailed Architectural and Engineering Design (DAED).

DILG MIMAROPA and NEDA MIMAROPA will adhere to the MIMAROPA

RGC Master Plan and Architectural Schematics approved by the RDC MIMAROPA and the MIMAROPA RGC DAED once formulated.

Copies of RGCMC Resolution No. 2023-02-01 was provided to DILG MIMAROPA on 15 June 2023.

On the recall of one hectare out of the 5.11 hectare land to be utilized as MIMAROPA RGC, it was suggested that a courtesy visit to Oriental Mindoro Governor Humerlito A. Dolor be arranged to discuss the issue and appeal for his consideration.

NEDA MIMAROPA visited the office of the Provincial Administrator on 24 August 2023 to discuss the matter.

On the attendance of heads of offices and agencies of RGCMC member to the next quarterly meeting, Mayor Morillo requested all regional directors and heads of agencies to attend the next meeting to directly respond to matters relative to the establishment of the MIMAROPA RGC and to affirm their commitment to transfer their respective regional offices in the MIMAROPA RGC in Calapan City.

All heads of RGCMC member agencies were invited to the third quarter meeting.

Governor Dolor made a query regarding the changes on the original RGC site development plan and mode of implementation wherein the DPWH will implement and construct all the regional government office buildings and will be funded as a whole.

Dir. Mendoza responded that no changes were made to the original drawing of the RGC site development plan. Per Committee's review of alternative financing options, it was decided that each agency will independently request funds for the construction of their respective office building.

Governor Dolor reiterated his request to construct a transport terminal as additional facility of the RGC. He cited that based on the usufruct agreement, the provincial government may introduce and include additional facilities inside the RGC. Governor Dolor also mentioned that the Committee may decide on the specific area inside the RGC site where the transport terminal can be built.

Governor Dolor also informed the Committee that the proposed transport terminal will no longer be a public terminal but will be solely for the use of all government employees of the RGC and other government offices around the area.

Dir. Mendoza suggested to meet with Governor Dolor and his Provincial Engineer's Office together with DPWH Oriental Mindoro DEO and Calapan City Planning and Development Office to further discuss the

concerns pertaining to the proposed establishment of transport terminal for the employees of RGC and other government offices within the vicinity of the RGC.

F. Matters for Approval/Review/Endorsement

- Lot allocations of Department of Migrant Workers (DMW) MIMAROPA, Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) MIMAROPA, and Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) MIMAROPA

EnP. Sarabia presented the proposed lot allocation of DMW MIMAROPA, CDA MIMAROPA, and DTI MIMAROPA in the MIMAROPA RGC.

She informed the Committee that DMW MIMAROPA Regional Coordinator Rhenejim June A. dela Cruz, through a letter dated 15 June 2023, requested inclusion of their regional office building in the MIMAROPA RGC located at Brgy. Sta. Isabel, Calapan City.

EnP. Sarabia cited that CDA MIMAROPA Regional Director Alberto A. Sabarias, through a letter dated 10 August 2023, expressed their intent to construct a CDA regional office building in the RGC site. She added that a budget of Php25 million is already available for the construction of CDA MIMAROPA office building.

She also reported that DTI MIMAROPA Regional Director Rodolfo J. Mariposque, through a letter dated 05 September 2023, requested for a lot allocation in the MIMAROPA RGC.

On motion duly seconded, the lot allocation of DMW MIMAROPA, CDA MIMAROPA and DTI MIMAROPA in the MIMAROPA RGC were approved with an estimated area ranging from 300 to 700 sq.m. per lot cut.

The lot area per RGO will be determined and provided in the MIMAROPA RGC DAED.

G. Matters for Information

- Updates on the construction of Commission on Population and Development (CPD) MIMAROPA regional office building

Engr. Villan presented updates on the construction of CPD MIMAROPA regional office building.

He reported that as of 19 September 2023, the actual physical accomplishment of the projects is at 61.55 percent with a negative slippage of 26.61 percent. He added that the delay in work activities is due to frequent rains and slow work progress on the side of the contractor.

207 in the RGC site is approximately 120 cubic meters and will be removed on

208 30 September 2023 as agreed.

210 He also mentioned that the temporary use of the RGC site as storage did

211 not result in any damage to the RGC site.

215 EnP. Sarabia reported the status of MIMAROPA Regional Government

218 She reported that currently, there are 64 possible RGC locators, which

219 consist of MIMAROPA RGOs, southern tagalog/cluster offices (agencies

220 that have not yet separated from the original Southern Tagalog or Region

221 IV set up), government owned and controlled corporations (GOCCs), and

222 other government offices.

223

224 EnP. Sarabia cited that out of 64 government agencies, there are 11

225 agencies that have established/built their respective offices outside the

226 RGC (either within Calapan City, within Oriental Mindoro, or in Puerto

227 Princesa City in Palawan).

228

229 She added that 25 agencies have already transferred to Calapan City or

230 within Oriental Mindoro but are renting office spaces.

231

232 She also informed the committee that nine agencies currently have lot

233 allocation in the RGC by virtue of RGCMC resolutions.

234

235 ARD Donna Mayor-Gardove of DENR MIMAROPA mentioned that they have

236 already submitted their request for lot allocation of DENR MIMAROPA, EMB

237 MIMAROPA and MGB MIMAROPA together with their request to co-locate

238 to maximize space distribution in the RGC site.

Subject: Updated RGC Master Plan

1. The RGCMC, during its first quarter meeting on 03 April 2017, recommended RDC approval of the proposed RGC site (5-hectare land located at Brgy. Sta. Isabel, Calapan City owned by the provincial government) to be used under a usufruct agreement which is renewable every 25 years.
2. Among the functions of the RGCMC are to identify the site of the RGC, cause for the preparation of a master plan for the RGC, and oversee all activities regarding the establishment of the RGC.
3. RDC MIMAROPA, during its second quarter meeting on 02 June 2017, adopted the conceptual design of the site development plan of the MIMAROPA Regional Government Center.
4. The DPWH MIMAROPA procured the consultancy services of Nepthy S. Del Rosario and Partners to formulate the MIMAROPA RGC master plan and architectural schematics.
5. The RDC MIMAROPA, through Resolution No. 2018-065-724 dated 06 December 2018, approved the MIMAROPA Regional Government Center Master Plan and Architectural Schematics.
6. In a meeting held on 26 September 2023, Governor Humerlito A. Dolor of Oriental Mindoro tasked the Provincial Engineer's Office (PEO) to facilitate the updating of the RGC master plan to include a transport terminal facility.
7. The draft RGC schematics were presented and reviewed during the meeting held on 02 October 2023, which was participated in by NEDA MIMAROPA, PEO, and DPWH District Engineering Office.
8. The PEO of the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro will present the updated RGC master plan.

Subject: Updates on the construction of Commission on Population and Development (CPD) MIMAROPA regional office building

1. Republic Act No. 10879 or the MIMAROPA Act establishing the Southwestern Tagalog to be known as the MIMAROPA region was enacted on 17 July 2016 in accordance with Article VI, Section 27 (1) of the Philippine Constitution.
2. Pursuant to the Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 10879 and Executive Order 682, s. 2007, Calapan City was designated as the regional center of MIMAROPA. In line with this, all regional government offices (RGOs) for MIMAROPA shall establish their offices in Calapan City.
3. In a letter dated 03 August 2022, Commission on Population and Development (CPD) MIMAROPA Regional Director Reynaldo O. Wong requested for the grant of 3,000 square meter parcel of land for the construction of CPD MIMAROPA regional office building in the RGC site located at Brgy. Sta. Isabel, Calapan City, Oriental Mindoro.
4. During the fourth quarter RGCMC meeting held on 22 November 2022 in Calapan City, the Committee approved the establishment of CPD MIMAROPA regional office building in the MIMAROPA RGC.
5. On 20 February 2023, a groundbreaking ceremony was held in the MIMAROPA RGC in Brgy. Sta. Isabel, Calapan City to mark the commencement of the construction of CPD MIMAROPA regional office building.
6. During the third quarter RGCMC meeting held on 19 September 2023 virtually via Zoom videoconference, the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) Oriental Mindoro District Engineering Office (DEO) reported that as of September 2023, the actual physical accomplishment of the projects is at 61.55 percent with a negative slippage of 26.61 percent.
7. DPWH Oriental Mindoro DEO will present updates on the construction of CPD MIMAROPA regional office building in the MIMAROPA RGC.
