Respectfully forwarding herewith is the Lawin Patrol Plan of the BPR Management Office within the Forest Conservation Area of BPR for the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter of 2023. The said Plan is the result of the reformulation of Lawin Patrol Plan of BPRMO, held on September 25, 2023, at 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor DENR CENRO Coron, Brgy. Poblacion V, Coron, Palawan.

On the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Patrol Plan, the BPRMO has retained the two (2) patrol sectors in Coron (Team 1) and Busuanga (Team 2) for implementation of Lawin System in the FCA of BPR which covers the two (2) municipalities of Coron and Busuanga. This consists of eleven (11) patrollers with target patrol distance of 34 kilometers for the month of November to December. To guide the patrollers in selecting the patrol routes for this quarter, the following criteria were used: threats observed and recorded during patrol in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter and 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2023 as well as results from previous year patrol routes that were not subjected for patrolling; areas with observed/reported illegal activities; during presentation and patrol planning of the BPRMO. Furthermore, the BPRMO take into consideration the comments and instructions based on the Lawin presentation of the BPRMO, that patrols should be clustered or focusing on one area to get the effectiveness of Lawin activity.


