



II. ACTIVITY BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the activity are the following:

- 1. Strengthen partnership and collaboration among stakeholders (e.g. Academe) when it comes to digitization;
- 2. Understand the background of project to be developed and implemented;
- 3. Present and discuss the submitted proposal by the MSC-CICS on the proposed OPFSTS; and
- 4. Formulate an OPFSTS Development Team.

III. ACTIVITY PROPER

The DENR-PENRO Marinduque through the Planning Section-ICT Unit headed by Information Systems Analyst II in coordination with Gemma P. Delos Reyes, In-Charge, Management Services Division and Dr. Ronjie Mar L. Malinao, Dean, College of Information and Computing Sciences/ Partner/Consultant conducted a Focus Group Discussion (FGD)/ Consultation Meeting on the Development and Implementation of Proposed Online PENRO Frontline Services Transaction System (OPFSTS) for DENR-PENRO Marinduque on November 21, 2023 at DENR-PENRO Conference Hall, Capitol Compound, Barangay Bangbangalon, Boac, Marinduque.

The activity was participated by the OIC – PENR Officer, Division Chiefs, selected Section Chiefs and Unit Heads from the Management Services Division and Technical Services Division of the DENR-PENRO Marinduque. Likewise, it was participated by OPFSTS Development Team from the Marinduque State College. It was facilitated by PENRO ICT Unit.

PENRO Imelda M. Diaz acted as the Presiding Officer. The opening program started with an Invocation followed by the Introduction of Participants by Contractual Administrative Assistant Janine Mae M. Semilla.

A message was delivered by OIC – PENR Officer Imelda M. Diaz where she thanked the Facilitator, OPFSTS Partner/Consultant from MSC-CICS and participants for their collaborative efforts and participation that made the activity possible. She emphasized the need of an online information system like the Online PENRO Frontline Services Transaction System (OPFSTS) in support to the Republic Act No. 11032 or the Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Government Service Delivery Act of 2018 and the Department's unwavering commitment towards advance digitalization.



Likewise, she highlighted that having an OPFSTS, we will be able to provide streamlined and standardized workflows in the delivery of Frontline Services. Moreover, she mentioned that such online system is fully supported by the DENR MIMAROPA Regional Executive Director.

Lastly, she expressed the gratitude to the OPFSTS Team from the Marinduque State College as Partner/Consultant for their assistance and support, time, knowledge and efforts in order to present the proposed OPFSTS for DENR-PENRO Marinduque, and hoping that the development of the information system will be pursued immediately.

IV. LECTURE PROPER

· Background and Objectives of the Activity

ISA II Mark Ryan S. Lozada extended his thanks and appreciation to the OPFSTS Partner/Consultant from MSC-CICS and all the participants who were present in the activity. He briefly and clearly identified and discussed the background and objectives of the activities as follows:

- 1. Strengthen partnership and collaboration among stakeholders (e.g. Academe) when it comes to digitalization;
- 2. Understand the background of project to be developed and implemented;
- Present and discuss the submitted proposal by the MSC-CICS on the proposed OPFSTS; and
- 4. Formulate an OPFSTS Development Team.

Likewise, he mentioned that the said innovation is in support with the Republic Act No. 11032 or the Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Government Service Delivery Act of 2018. He discussed the frontline services that will be covered by the OPFSTS which will cover seven (7) Frontline Services of the Forest Management Sector and five (5) Frontline Services of the Biodiversity Management Sector.

Presentation of Proposed OPFSTS for DENR-PENRO Marinduque

OPFSTS Partner/Consultant Dr. Ronjie Mar L. Malinao thanked the management of the DENR-PENRO Marinduque on the digital collaboration and partnership established between DENR-PENRO Marinduque and Marinduque State College. He mentioned that they are very much willing to collaborate and partner with the DENR-PENRO Marinduque on digitalization initiatives. He briefly gave an introduction/background and mandate of MSC-College of Information and Computing Sciences. He further discussed the processes on the commencement of project, which will undergo series of proposal presentations to MSC Research and Extension Committee, then to be approved by the MSC Academic Council and afterwards by the MSC Board of Trustees.

The proposed information system will initially focus on the five (5) Frontline Services of the Biodiversity Management Sector. He presented the detailed proposal of the project which include the Background and Rationale, Objectives, Project Description, Methodology, Gantt Chart, Project Management, and Wireframes for the proposed information system. Proposed Project Line-Item



Budget (LIB) was also presented which contains the proposed and estimated project cost. Moreover, he discussed the features and functionalities of the online system which covers the online application, monitoring, payment, generation of permits and reports.

Afterwards, Ms. Christine May L. Nabos, Research and Extension Coordinator of MSC-CICS presented the draft Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the DENR-PENRO Marinduque and Marinduque State College. Atty. Vicente L. Fabrero II, Legal Researcher of DENR-PENRO Marinduque reviewed and provided initial comments to be incorporated in the draft MOA.

Open Forum

During and after the presentation, participants were given the opportunity to ask questions and clarifications. The following were the concerns raised:

1. System Features and Functionalities

- The DENR-PENRO Marinduque and MSC-CICS will conduct series of meetings/consultations to further discuss the system features and functionalities to be included in the proposed system
- The project title will be revised into Online PENRO Frontline Services on Biodiversity Management System

2. Ownership

 If fully-implemented, the system will be an intellectual property and copyright by DENR-PENRO Marinduque and MSC-CICS

3. System Costs

 Development, implementation and maintenance costs will be shared by DENR-PENRO Marinduque and MSC-CICS

Ways Forward

Below are the summary of agreements of both parties:

- No funds available allotted and programmed for the development and implementation of the proposed OPFSTS for CY 2023 and CY 2024, thus the following options were identified:
 - a. Request for Supplemental Budget for the development and implementation of the proposed OPFSTS for CY 2024;
 - b. Identify relevant Programs/Projects/Activities (PPAs) where portion of funds can be allotted for the project development and implementation;
 - c. Reduce the cost to be shared by the DENR-PENRO Marinduque as counterpart on the project development and implementation; and
 - d. Review if there are any guidelines on the utilization of collection from the biodiversity revenue deposited to Bureau of Treasury (BoT).
- PENRO Planning Section/ICT Unit to include in the proposal for CY 2025 the development and implementation of the Online PENRO Frontline Services on Forestry Management System;



- 3. Submitted proposal shall be reviewed by the DENR-PENRO Marinduque, and comments shall be submitted to MSC-CICS. Revised project proposal and Project Line-Item Budget (LIB) will be presented again by MSC-CICS to DENR-PENRO Marinduque for finalization and approval; and
- 4. The draft MOA shall be submitted by the MSC-CICS containing the comments given by Atty. Fabrero II for review by the DENR-PENRO Marinduque, and will be presented again by MSC-CICS to DENR-PENRO Marinduque for finalization and approval.

V. CLOSING PROGRAM

Certificates of Appreciation were awarded to the OPFSTS Team for their commendable effort and assistance extended as Partner/Consultant on the Development and Implementation of Proposed Online PENRO Frontline Services Transaction System (OPFSTS) for DENR-PENRO Marinduque. 
