This significant event is scheduled for January 26-28, 2024, at the Occidental Mindoro State College in San Jose, Occidental Mindoro.

The 3-in1 event is organized to invite the participation of stakeholders of DRRM and CCA in the academe, NGO's, government agencies, and local government units. Part of the convention are presentations on climate change and disaster risk.
