The Executive Order No. 70 aims to attain inclusive and sustainable peace through intensified development and other peace-building initiatives in conflict-affected and vulnerable communities. The Handog Titulo Program under Republic Act (RA) No. 6940 and No. 10023 was identified by the Department to serve as support to the Order's implementation.

With this, you are hereby instructed to review and assess the list of barangays affected and threatened by CTG as provided by the National Security Council (NSC) based on the current situation on the ground and come up with priority areas to be included in the land disposition activities for Fiscal Year 2021. A proposed Work and Financial Plan (WFP) shall be submitted to the Land Management Bureau (LMB) through the Land Policy and Planning Division before or not later than August 20, 2020.

LMB will be sending the list of CTG affected and threatened areas of each Region via the official email address of the Regional Executive Director's Office and the Regional Planning Division.
