DENUDED PORTIONS OF THE FOREST IN THE

PROVINCE OF PALAWAN

This is to acknowledge receipt of your Memorandum dated 11 September 2023 regarding the above-mentioned subject. In this regard, this office is providing the following comments and recommendations on the proposed Aerial Seeding in Palawan, to wit:

- The Ecosystems Research and Development Bureau's (ERDB) technology on "Fortified Seeds" was tested on the conventional field planting technique however, no trials were ever made through aerial seeding. This means that we have no empirical data on the field performance (survival rate) of our "fortified seeds" should it be planted via aerial seeding. Thus, there is no guarantee on the success of said technique if the objective is to reforest barren and inaccessible areas since ERDB's "fortified seeds" were not designed for such planting method (aerial dropping); and
  - Logistics limitation poses to be a problem for this planting method since we do not know any individual or entity who has the skills and appropriate equipment/facilities to do the job. Granted that facilities are available, we still cannot determine its economic feasibility considering its possible cost with no guaranteed rate of success.

In view of the foregoing, it is suggested that the Leave a Nest Philippines, Inc. with business address: Unit 501. 5F West Trade Center, West Avenue, Quezon City, 1104 Metro Manila, Philippines is said to be promoting a technology on aerial seeding that was introduced to the Philippines by Japanese scientist. However, the said technology has limited trials conducted in the country.

### RESOLUTION NO. 17614 Series of 2023

REQUESTING THE HONORABLE MARIA ANTONIA YULO-LOYZAGA, SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES (DENR) TO CONDUCT AERIAL SEEDING IN SOME DENUDED PORTIONS OF FORESTS IN THE PROVINCE OF PALAWAN

WHEREAS, known for its beauty and blessed with incredibly awesome landscapes, outstanding dive sites, majestic mountains, primeval caves, and pristine beaches, Palawan is a long, narrow island in the southwest Philippines that's sanctuary to a rich array of flora, fauna, and marine life. An anchor tourist destination, Palawan is one of the 7,641 islands that make up the Philippine archipelago;

WHEREAS, accounting for the bulk of the nation's forest cover, the Palawan rainforest is considered to be the last ecological frontier in the archipelago nation. Almost half of Palawan's topography is steep mountainous. Over 3,500 flowering plant species with 20% endemism are known from the island. The vegetation types are diverse, forest have been home to indigenous people for thousands of years;

WHEREAS, a recent study conducted by the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, and Project Sibol, which is run by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), revealed that since 2005, the province has lost 98,000 hectares of primary forest and 3,000 hectares of mangrove forest;

WHEREAS, the said study also revealed that majority of forests had been degraded or lost due to agricultural expansion, increasing human settlement, and unabated kaingin farming;

WHEREAS, other problems include landslides, siltation, the loss of homes, communities, and wildlife, the loss of a way to make a living, the spread of illegal logging, and quarrying;

WHEREAS, with illegal logging, wildlife poaching, mangrove loss, agro-industrial development, and unsustainable mining continue to take place at alarming rates, it contributes significantly to the ongoing loss of Palawan's rainforest of about 5,500 hectares every year – the equivalent of 7,700 football pitches;

WHEREAS, aerial seeding is a means of reforesting bald portions of forests in the province which is the most practical and economical way to reforest and restore forest trees in the denuded mountains in the province;

WHEREAS, aerial seeding is a technique of plantation wherein seed balls – seeds covered with a mixture of clay, compost, char and other components – are sprayed on the ground using aerial devices, including planes, helicopters or drones in times suitable for the seeds and plants to grow;

WHEREAS, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) will intensify the government's national greening program by planting trees on more than two million hectares of land by 2028 in line with the directive of His Excellency President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. to focus on reforestation efforts in the country;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Roseller S. Pineda duly seconded, be it

**RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, to request the Honorable Maria Antonia Yulo-Loyzaga, Secretary of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) to conduct aerial seeding in some denuded portions of forests in the Province of Palawan;
