## Seminar description:

Wetlands are one of the many ecosystems providing valuable services and which can play an important role in reducing risk to certain hazards, as well as in supporting climate change adaptation. The Wetlands and Disaster Risk Reduction: A Guide for Wetland Managers published in December 2022, provides a practical guide for wetland managers to incorporate Eco-DRR approaches into their management plans. This webinar will introduce the guide and the role that wetlands can play in reducing disaster risk, as well as present case studies, with a focus on the Asia and Pacific region, where these ecosystems are playing a role in disaster management. We will also have ample time for discussion and Q&A so participants can share their experiences.
