Further to BMB Memorandum dated 14 August 2023 on the conduct of Orientation of UNESCO Programmes for the Philippine Natural Heritage, please be informed that the Orientation for the Visayas and Mindanao Cluster has already been conducted on 12-14 September 2023 in Davao City. The said Orientation provided a platform to discuss the salient features and nomination processes of the UNESCO World Heritage Sites (WHS), Man and Biosphere Reserves (MABR), and UNESCO Global Geopark Program (aUGGP).

While the Orientation for the Luzon Cluster will be scheduled in 1st Quarter of CY 2024, we are pleased to provide you the attached copy of the highlights of the discussions during the Visayas and Mindanao Cluster Orientation for your reference.

WHS are areas with Outstanding Universal Value (OUV) to humanity in terms of cultural, natural, or a combination of both aspects. Currently, the Philippines has 19 sites listed in the WHS Tentative List (TL) of which the following protected areas in Luzon were included:

Further, it can be noted from the discussions during the Visayas and Mindanao Cluster that for aspiring sites to be eligible for nomination under the WHS program, they must first be included in the WHS TL. Hence, for aspiring protected areas within your respective Regions, please take note of the following deadlines and requirements:
