In this regard, may we request you to please conduct assessment, evaluation and recommendation for possible inclusion of the said activity in the Enhanced National Greening Program (ENGP). Specifically, the following must be considered in the assessment and coordination with the Provincial Government of Palawan:

- Is the proposed denuded forest for rehabilitation through aerial seeding covered . under the LGU's forest land use plan? Is the proposed site condition feasible for aerial seeding? How many hectares are potential reforestation sites? Is this already mapped out? With existing or on-going NGP projects in the proposed area?
- What is the scope of the activities for the proposed project? What specific commodities or species do they intend to plant? Required quantity and quality of seeds? sowing method? Post-seedling management arrangement?
- What is the proposed aircraft to be use? Allocation of funds to cover operational cost per flight and other expenses? Is the cost of operation can be covered by the regular NGP activity cost? Duration of the project?
- Who will be the potential partner organizations?
- What could the LGU commit should this proposal be pursued? Would the LGU provide funding?

We would appreciate receiving updates on actions you have taken regarding this matter.

Palawan is a long, narrow island in the southwest Philippines that's sanctuary to a rich array of flora, fauna, and marine life. An anchor tourist destination, Palawan is one of the 7,641 islands that make up the Philippine archipelago;

WHEREAS, accounting for the bulk of the nation's forest cover, the Palawan rainforest is considered to be the last ecological frontier in the archipelago nation. Almost half of Palawan's topography is steep mountainous. Over 3,500 flowering plant species with 20% endemism are known from the island. The vegetation types are diverse, forest have been home to indigenous people for thousands of years;

WHEREAS, a recent study conducted by the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, and Project Sibol, which is run by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), revealed that since 2005, the province has lost 98,000 hectares of primary forest and 3,000 hectares of mangrove forest;

WHEREAS, the said study also revealed that majority of forests had been degraded or lost due to agricultural expansion, increasing human settlement, and unabated kaingin farming;

WHEREAS, other problems include landslides, siltation, the loss of homes, communities, and wildlife, the loss of a way to make a living, the spread of illegal logging, and quarrying;

WHEREAS, with illegal logging, wildlife poaching, mangrove loss, agro-industrial development, and unsustainable mining continue to take place at alarming rates, it contributes significantly to the ongoing loss of Palawan's rainforest of about 5,500 hectares every year - the equivalent of 7,700 football pitches:

WHEREAS, aerial seeding is a means of reforesting bald portions of forests in the province which is the most practical and economical way to reforest and restore forest trees in the denuded mountains in the province;

WHEREAS, aerial seeding is a technique of plantation wherein seed balls – seeds covered with a mixture of clay, compost, char and other components – are sprayed on the ground using aerial devices, including planes, helicopters or drones in times suitable for the seeds and plants to grow;

WHEREAS, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) will intensify the government's national greening program by planting trees on more than two million hectares of land by 2028 in line with the directive of His Excellency President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. to focus on reforestation efforts in the country;




