WHEREAS, Article 2, Section 2, of DAO No. 2020-12 provides that "Applicants must possess the financial capacity prescribed by the Inter-Agency Committee to undertake dredging operations";

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of DPWH Regional Director IV-B Engr. Yolanda L. Tangco, duly seconded by other members present, **BE IT RESOLVED**, as this body hereby resolves to set the following minimum financial and technical capacity to undertake dredging operations in the Province of Occidental Mindoro in accordance with DENR Administrative Order No. 2020-12:


- For Large Rivers / 3rd Order Stream – ONE BILLION PESOS (PhP1,000,000,000.00) Authorized Capital Stock, 25% of which is subscribed and paid up.
- For Medium Rivers / 2nd Order Stream – THREE HUNDRED MILLION PESOS (PhP300,000,000.00) Authorized Capital Stock, 25% of which is subscribed and paid up.
- For Small Rivers / 1st Order Stream – ONE HUNDRED MILLION PESOS (PhP100,000,000.00) Authorized Capital Stock, 25% of which is subscribed and paid up.



- For Small Rivers/1st Order Stream – ONE MILLION PESOS (PhP1,000,000.00).

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2020-12**

FINANCIAL CAPABILITY

Interested parties must submit together with their Letter of Intent the following :

1. Company Profile / Brochures
2. SEC Certificate of Registration and Articles of Incorporation
3. 2020 General Information Sheet
 - a. For LARGE RIVERS / 3rd Order Stream - ONE BILLION PESOS (PhP 1,000,000,000.00) minimum Authorized Capital Stock, 25% of which needs to be Subscribed and Paid-up;
 - b. For MEDIUM RIVERS / 2nd Order Stream - THREE HUNDRED MILLION PESOS (PhP 300,000,000.00) minimum Authorized Capital Stock, 25% of which needs to be Subscribed and Paid-up;
 - c. For SMALL RIVERS / 1st Order Stream - ONE HUNDRED MILLION PESOS (PhP 100,000,000.00) minimum Authorized Capital Stock, 25% of which needs to be Subscribed and Paid-up;
4. In case of Joint Venture, Partnership or Consortium, one of the members must possess the above prescribed FINANCIAL CAPABILITY.
5. The Corporation, Joint Venture, Partnership or Consortium must be 100% Filipino-owned
6. Notarized Joint Venture, Partnership or Consortium Agreement

TECHNICAL COMPETENCE

Interested parties must submit the following requirements :

1. List of Equipment (with details whether Owned, Leased or Letter of Support)
2. Pictures of Equipment
3. Specification of Equipment
4. As to the Equipment, applicant should at least own some of the land based Equipment such as backhoes and dump trucks
5. Estimated Dredging Output per Month of Equipment (in cubic meters)
6. Construction Methodology in dredging the river mouths to the river channels
7. Designated Disposal Area of Dredged Materials (show location and corresponding permits, if any)
8. Letter of Affirmation that Dredging Operations will start within thirty (30) days after receipt of the Notice to Proceed (NTP) issued by the Provincial Government as required by the DAO 2020-12, Section 4.a
9. Track Record on dredging activities or similar works




