**SUMMARY OF CONCERNS AND AGREEMENTS ON THE INTER-AGENCY COMMITTEE MEETING ON 09 May 2023**

Topics # 1 and #2

**Approval of the March 30, 2023 Minutes of Meeting.**

**Ruling on the Reconsideration of the Cancellation of the Notice of Pre-qualification of Bataan Aggregates Corporation Joint Venture Anglo Philippine Holdings Corporation and Vibranium Land Development and Technology, OPC.**

On 06 December 2022, the IAC conducted a meeting at the Mines and Geosciences Bureau – MIMAROPA Conference Hall to discuss the TWG and FWG’s endorsement. Thereafter, the IAC issued Resolution No. 04 - 2022 confirming Bataan Aggregates Corporation Joint Venture with Anglo Philippine Holdings Corporation and Vibranium Land Development and Technology, OPC’s application as the pre-qualified proponent for Longos River.

On 14 February 2023, the Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, Ph.D. called for a meeting with the pre-qualified proponents to remind them of the submission of the Draft Dredging Master Plan. The representatives from the joint venture of Bataan Aggregates, Anglo Philippine Holdings Corporation, and Vibranium Land Development and Technology, OPC were present and committed to submitting the required Dredging Master Plan on or before 15 March 2023. Otherwise, the joint venture’s Notice of Award would be canceled.

Despite several follow-ups, the joint venture failed to submit its Draft Master Dredging Plan and on 30 March 2023, the IAC cancelled the Notice of Award to Bataan Aggregates joint venture Anglo Philippine Holdings Corporation and Vibranium Land Development and Technology, OPC by virtue of Resolution No. 01-2023.

He will give his approval or disapproval on the matters to discuss. The DPWH already gave his assent to all the topics today. Can we now call the meeting to order Atty. Turano?</p>	<p><b>Atty. <p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>We just informed RED Claudio that we are already about to start the meeting so she will join later. We will follow the agenda as we already distributed to the IAC Members, Governor. Our first agenda is the approval of the minutes of the meeting on March 30, 2023. What we will do Governor to fast track the proceedings is we will just provide the members the printed copies of our minutes concerning the previous meetings for their review.</p>	<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>Okay, so we will not proceed with the approval today?</p>
	<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>Yes, Governor. We will dispense with the approval of the minutes last March 30, 2023 and move forward so that everyone will be given sufficient opportunity to study and peruse the minutes for their comments, Governor. What we will do is, if the present members will agree; we will just append a referendum on the minutes that within five (5) days that they have any question or comments on the minutes we will make the necessary changes. If they approve the minutes, it will be through a referendum,</p>
<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>I think Atty. Turano, it will be better if there will be a motion to dispense with the reading and give a copy of the same to the members. If within the five (5) day period, they will not be able to submit their comments, suggestions, or objections, then it is deemed approved.</p>	<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>Yes, Governor. May we request from the members present for a motion to dispense with the readings of the minutes, provided that, copies of the minutes will be provided to the respective members and within a period of five (5) days, without any comment or request for revision, the minutes will be deemed approved.</p>
<p><b>Regional Director Glenn Marcelo C. Noble</b></p> <p>Mr. Chairperson, I move to dispense with the readings of the minutes during our meeting last March 30, 2023 with the agreement that the Members shall be given a copy of the minutes</p>	

<p>and that they are given five (5) days to provide their comments, if there is any, if none, then it will be deemed approved by the Members of the IAC.</p>	
<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>There is a motion, is there any second from the other Members, or from Atty. Custodio?</p>	<p><b>Engineer Buenafe A. Rioflorido</b></p> <p>I second the motion.</p>
	<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>Thank you Engineer. Any objection? None? Approved. Then we proceed to the next item. Our next item is about what?</p>
<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>Governor, our next agenda is the resolution of the Motion for Reconsideration filed by the joint venture of Bataan Aggregates Corporation, Anglo Philippine Holdings Corporation, and Vibranium Land Development and Technology, OPC. This pertains to the cancellation of the Notice of Award given to the said joint venture for the Longos River located in the Municipality of Baco, Governor.</p>	
<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>Can you please explain briefly the antecedent facts or chronology of events before we act on the Motion for Reconsideration?</p>	<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>We will share it your Honor. For the record Governor, through Viber we provided the respective members with a copy of the Executive Briefer, Governor.</p>
<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>Yes, just for our discussion and for all the members to be updated. Please give us the highlights of the circumstances.</p>	
<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>Yes, Governor. The application for the Longos River started as early as the year 2020. It was first awarded to Vibranium Land Development and Technology, OPC joint venture with Sunwest Construction Corporation last July 7, 2020. However, your Honor, similar to previously awarded rivers, the joint venture of</p>	

<p>Vibranium Land Development and Technology, OPC and Sunwest Construction Corporation was not able to submit their Draft Dredging Master Plan. That is the reason why all the pre-qualified proponents were eventually disqualified for failure to submit the necessary Draft Dredging Master Plan. During the second round of pre-qualification, we selected new applicants.</p>	
<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>When did the second round of pre-qualification happen and the date of cancellation? It was last year If I remember it correctly.</p>	<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>The cancellation was made on October 14, 2022, Governor. During the same meeting, the IAC agreed to reopen the river systems whose pre-qualified proponents were disqualified, or whose Notices of Award were cancelled. Included in this reopening is the river system of Longos River, also known as the Baco River.</p>
<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>On November 3, 2022, there was a pre-submission conference which was attended by representatives from Bataan Aggregates Corporation and Vibranium Land Development and Technology, OPC.</p>	
<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>On December 1, 2022, there was an agreement that the TWG and FWG shall first evaluate and screen the applications. Bataan Aggregates Corporation (Bataan Aggregates) joint venture Anglo Philippine Holdings Corporation (Anglo) and Vibranium Land Development and Technology, OPC (Vibranium) submitted their application and their proposal was included for the same Longos River.</p>	
<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>On December 6, 2022, the IAC issued a Resolution granting the Notice of Prequalification given to the joint venture of Bataan Aggregates, Anglo, and Vibranium for Longos River. This was the same river system which was applied by Vibranium during the first round of application. It is noticeable that Vibranium was also part of the joint venture</p>	

<p>which applied for Longos River during this round of application.</p>	
<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>If you will recall Governor, on February 14, 2023, you had a personal meeting with all the representatives of all the pre-qualified proponents. The representative from Bataan Aggregates was also present during that meeting. In that meeting, it was agreed by everyone, including the representative from Bataan Aggregates that the Draft Dredging Master Plan must be submitted on or before March 15, 2023. Of all pre-qualified proponents who attended that meeting, only Bataan Aggregates was unable to timely submit its Draft Dredging Master Plan.</p>	<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>I think including River Delta Development Corporation (River Delta).</p>
<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>Yes, Governor, including River Delta. Both Bataan Aggregates and River Delta failed to submit their Draft Dredging Master Plan. However, Governor, we made follow ups to Bataan Aggregates and River Delta for the submission, even after March 15, 2023. River Delta did not bother to communicate with us Governor. Aside from text messages, there was no formal communication as to whether they are intending to submit their compliance. With respect to Bataan Aggregates, we made a follow-up on March 15, 2023. They acknowledged receipt of our letter on March 22, 2023. Nevertheless, they did not have any definite commitment when to submit their documents. They just asked for an extension because the Dredging Master Plan was being prepared, but there was no definite period for them to submit.</p>	<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>Okay.</p>
<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>On March 30, 2023, the IAC had a meeting at the Governor's Conference Hall in Calapan City, where it was unanimously agreed upon that due to the need to immediately dredge the two (2) rivers in the Municipality of Baco which cause perennial flooding, the pre-qualification granted to Bataan Aggregates and River Delta were both cancelled. That was through Resolution 01-2023.</p>	

<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>On April 19, 2023, Bataan Aggregates submitted a letter to the Office of the Governor requesting for reconsideration. On April 28, 2023, they again wrote. However, despite the motions for reconsideration, they only submitted their Draft Master Dredging Plan on May 2, 2023 to the Office of the Governor. Practically, the joint venture only submitted last week. The submission was made well beyond the initial agreed period of March 15, 2023.</p>	<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>Originally, it was on February 28, 2023, then we extended it to March 15, 2023.</p>
<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>We actually gave the joint venture of Bataan Aggregates, Anglo, and Vibranium another opportunity. We sent them a letter on March 16, 2023 which they received on March 22, 2023. In our letter, we required them to submit the Draft Dredging Master Plan within seven (7) days from receipt. There was no definite commitment on their end when to submit. It was only after the Members of the IAC decided to cancel the pre-qualification given to them that the joint venture decided to submit a Draft Dredging Master Plan. Nevertheless Governor, there were two (2) letters as motions for reconsideration, but the actual Draft Dredging Master Plan was actually received by the Office of the Governor on May 2, 2023.</p>	<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>Okay, that is the antecedent fact. More than two (2) months from the date of deadline has lapsed.</p>
<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>Six (6) weeks, Governor, is the time that passed that the joint venture submitted after we cancelled the pre-qualification and posted the notice of acceptance; after we received applications for Longos and Alag Rivers, Governor.</p>	
<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>With these, are there any comments on the part of the Members of the IAC?</p>	<p><b>Regional Director Glenn Marcelo C. Noble</b></p> <p>Mr. Chairperson, if I may, I believe enough time has been given to the joint venture of Bataan Aggregates, Anglo, and Vibranium. Considering that such time lapsed and the pre-qualified proponent was not able to submit their Draft Dredging Master plan. What now is our assurance that they will implement the project soon? This is only the</p>



	<p>submission stage, how much more is the consequence if they are going to implement the River Restoration Program? We might have bigger problems with the joint venture that is my position on the matter. Thank you.</p>
<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>Thank you RD Noble. Atty. Custodio from the DPWH, what is your stand?</p>	<p><b>Atty. James Corwin S. Custodio</b></p> <p>Governor, we received a copy of the Executive Summary and RD Pacanan is of the same opinion and view as that of RD Noble.</p>
<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>Thank you very much. How about the representatives from the EMB?</p>	<p><b>Engineer Buenafe A. Rioflorido</b></p> <p>Sir, I am of the same opinion as RD Noble. I think that we have given them ample time to prepare the Dredging Master Plan. Since they submitted already, will it take us more time if we will allow other applicants to submit their documents? However, if that is the agreement of the Body, then we will support that, Governor.</p>
<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>Is RED Claudio already here? She is not here? I think that RED Claudio will have the same sentiments with the majority of the members.</p>	
<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>RD Salino, good afternoon.</p>	<p><b>Regional Director Joe Amil M. Salino</b></p> <p>Hello, good afternoon everyone. We just came from Congress so I was not able to join earlier. I was with RED Claudio a while ago.</p>
<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>I will just ask for your stand on the matter. The MGB and DPWH both stipulated not to entertain the motion for reconsideration of the joint venture of Bataan Aggregates, Anglo, and Vibranium anymore given that we already gave them ample time to prepare the Draft Master Dredging Plan. Since two (2) months already lapsed since the cancellation, they only submitted on May 2, 2023, how much more during the implementation.</p>	<p><b>Regional Director Joe Amil M. Salino</b></p> <p>I have no objection to that.</p>

	<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>Thank you RD Salino. I think that RED Claudio shares the same sentiment. Is there any motion that the Body unanimously sets aside the motion for reconsideration or otherwise archive this matter?</p>
<p><b>Regional Director Glenn Marcelo C. Noble</b></p> <p>Motion, your Honor.</p>	<p><b>Regional Director Joe Amil M. Salino</b></p> <p>I second the motion.</p>
<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>Seconded by RD Salino, any objection? None? Approved.</p>

Topic #3

Presentation of Evaluated Documents of Applicants for River Restoration and Dredging Activities in the Province of Oriental Mindoro

On 05 May 2023, the Technical and Financial Working Groups for River Restoration and Dredging Activities in the Province of Oriental Mindoro convened to pre-evaluate and recommend the applicants who are financially and technically capable to undertake river restoration through large-scale dredging activities. The following applicants were screened with their corresponding river systems and are now presented to the IAC for approval:

- 1. Bird’s Nest Resources Corporation – Cluster of Longos and Alag Rivers located in the Municipality of Baco;

2. Triton Construction and Development Corporation joint venture Sands Mining and Development Corporation – Subaang River located in the Municipality of San Teodoro;
3. Buildnet Construction Incorporated joint venture Pasig River Expressway Corporation - Cluster of Wasig, Cagankan, and Mansalay Rivers located in the Municipality of Mansalay; and
4. Artholand Property Development Incorporated joint venture Pasig River Expressway Corporation - Cluster of Maujao and Cawacat Rivers located in the Municipality of Bulalacao.

ISSUES/CONCERNS	COMMENTS/AGREEMENTS
<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>For agenda number three (3), the endorsement of the evaluated submissions for the cluster of Longos and Alag Rivers, Subaang River, cluster of Wasig, Cagankan, and Mansalay Rivers, and the cluster of Maujao and Cawacat Rivers. During our last IAC meeting Governor, the members of the IAC agreed that due to the sizes of some river systems, it is not financially feasible for private proponents to venture in river restoration of small river systems. That is why the IAC decided there will be clustering based on the location of the rivers. There is a cluster for Longos and Alag Rivers which are both located in the Municipality of Baco. A cluster for Wasig, Cagankan, and Mansalay Rivers which are located in the Municipality of Mansalay. A cluster for Maujao and Cawacat Rivers located in the Municipality of Bulalacao. For Subaang River which is located in the Municipality of San Teodoro is not part of any cluster. As far as Pula River is concerned governor, we did not include it in agenda number three (3) because there was no proponent who was pre-qualified.</p>	
<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>During the TWG and FWG meeting last May 2, 2023, there were submissions for Pula River but none of the pre-qualified for the financial qualification. In fact, we even relaxed its rules and requested the proponents who were not pre-qualified to submit their documents to substantiate that they are qualified at least financially, so that we would not have to repost and invite prospective applicants for Pula River since it is just a small river system. However,</p>	

<p>we cannot cluster it with other river systems because it is far from the others.</p>	
<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>Again Governor, I already provided a copy through Viber of the soft copy of the summary. We are sharing to the screen the summary.</p>	<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>We will just review the river systems, which of the rivers are involved here?</p>
	<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>The cluster of Alag and Longos Rivers, Governor.</p>
<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>For Alag and Longos Rivers, how many are the applicants?</p>	<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>Actually there is only one (1) Governor who qualified but there are two (2) applicants, Bird's Nest Resources Corporation and RMS Petroleum Technology and Waste Management Corporation (RMS Petroleum). In fact, RMS Petroleum applied to almost all the rivers.</p>
<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>Governor, RED Claudio will be joining us in a while.</p>	<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>Okay, very good.</p>
<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>Governor, to recap, there are two (2) applicants for the cluster of Alag and Longos Rivers but only Bird's Nest Resources Corporation qualified financially for the Two Hundred Fifty Million paid up capital. RMS Petroleum already participated before and for the same reason it was disqualified. According to RMS Petroleum, they are banking on the provision of the Corporation Code, but we are under the Department Administrative Order No. 14-2019. We are constantly reminding the applicants that we need One Billion authorized capital stock and at least Two Hundred Fifty Million paid up capital.</p>

The other one is Chosen One Land Development Corporation.</p>
<p><b>Atty. Earl Ligorio R. Turano II</b></p> <p>There were two (2) submissions Governor. Buildnet Construction Incorporated joint venture Pasig River Expressway Corporation or PAREX. PAREX has an authorized capital of Three Billion, subscribed capital of One Billion Eight Hundred Million, and Paid-up capital of Two Billion Five Hundred Million.</p>	<p><b>Regional Director Glenn Marcelo C. Noble</b></p> <p>The paid-up capital is larger than the subscribed capital, is that possible Atty. Turano? Can it be done? There is nothing to subscribe for this.</p>

Governor, Chosen One submitted only one (1) document, the Certificate of Approval of Increase of Capital Stock. We informed Chosen One in writing to submit proof that they are financially pre-qualified. We waited until May 4, 2023, that was last Thursday but we did not receive any document. In fact Governor, we scheduled a second meeting of the TWG and FWG specifically just to wait for the submission of Chosen One. We informed them through calls and text messages and they responded that they could not meet the deadline.</p>	<p><b>Governor Humerlito A. Assignment of Rights from GC8 Kinming Corporation to GC8 Dredging and Reclamation Corporation

In a letter dated 04 May 2023, GC8 Dredging and Reclamation Corporation sent a letter addressed to the Governor to allow the change of the named pre-qualified proponent from GC8 Kinming Incorporated to GC8 Dredging and Reclamation Corporation. In said letter, it was stipulated that GC8 Dredging and Reclamation Corporation is holding interests in GC8 Kinming and as a parent company, GC8 Dredging and Reclamation Corporation has the authority to make decisions affecting the operations and strategic direction of GC8 Kinming.

We are presenting the letter request from GC8 Dredging dated May 4, 2023 and Reclamation Corporation that they be allowed to substitute GC8 Kinming, Incorporationg for dredging activities as the pre-qualified proponent for Bucayao River. Based on this letter, GC8 Kinming is under the umbrella of GC8 Dredging and Reclamation Corporation. However, Governor, there is no attached document to the said letter, Deed of Assignment, or any substantiation to prove that GC8 Dredging and Reclamation Corporation as assignee is qualified financially and technically to undertake river restoration Governor.</p>

I communicated with one onf their lawyers, she said that the Deed of Assignment lacks the signatures of the respective representatives of the two (2) corporations. They really tried, but that is why they were not able to bring the documents today, Governor. Same as with the qualification of GC8 Dredging and Reclamation Corporation, they were not able to submit the documents to substantiate the fact that they are pre-qualified; same with GC8 Kinming, Incorporated.</p>

Dolor, MPA, PH.D.</b></p> <p>Our meeting will probably be next month, and just to facilitate this matter, considering that it will be the rainy season soon, then I request the members to come to an agreement, that if ever the request of GC8 Kinming for the transfer of the rights, GC8 Dredging and Reclamation Corporation will be able to submit by next week the document to substantiate their proof of financial and technical capacities. I request that we will just send the documents to the other members of the IAC and we will approve the transfer of rights through the issuance of a Resolution so that we will not call for another meeting just for this purpose.</p>	<p><b>Regional Director Glenn Marcelo C. Noble</b></p> <p>I concur with you Governor, but with the agreement that GC8 Dredging and Reclamation Corporation and GC8 Kinming Incorporated shall submit both of their documents attesting to the fact of transfer of rights. 
