PARALEGAL TRAINING FOR THE DEPUTATION OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES OFFICERS (DENROs) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BROOKE'S POINT, PALAWAN

Conference Room, DENR- CENRO Brooke's Point, Palawan September 27-29, 2023

BACKGROUND

The DENR, is the primary agency mandated to conserve and protect the diverse natural resources, wildlife species and their habitats. It is also the lead agency responsible for implementing the provisions of Presidential Decree 705 as amended. As part of DENR mission, which is to mobilize the citizenry in the protection, conservation and management of environment and natural resources, DENR Administrative Order No. 2008-22 was issued, providing revised guidelines for the Deputation of Environment and Natural Resources Officers (DENRO's).

One of the key principles outlined in the guidelines is to engage in participatory activities involving stakeholders from various agencies and sectors of society. Thus, the Ipilan Nickel Mining Corporation (INC) is considered a valuable and potential partner in the efforts to protect and manage the environment and natural resources in the municipality of Brooke's Point.

RATIONALE:

Presidential Decree 705, known as the Forestry Code of the Philippines and as amended, outlines the Laws and regulations governing the use and protection of forestlands. However, the DENR (Department of Environment and Natural Resources) continue to face challenges in its implementation, despite having identified potential solutions. These challenges arise from limited resources, including financial constraints for manpower, a shortage of personnel assigned to fieldwork, and inadequate equipment.

Given the pressing environmental concerns and issues confronting DENR- CENRO (Centralized Enforcement and Investigation Division), it has become imperative to collaborate with partners and communities in educating them about environmental provisions. This includes familiarizing them with the provisions of PD 705, DAO 97-32 concerning apprehension on forestry matters, RA 9147 for Wildlife, RA 7942 for Mining, and RA 7586 as amended by RA 11038 (ENIPAS), along with the legal foundations governing the cutting, transporting, and harvesting of forest trees within Timberland and Private Land.

To address these challenges, the DENR is committed to adopt a common understanding and enhancing knowledge of both technical and legal requirements for effective environmental protection, conservation, and sustainable resource development. Additionally, the DENR's Thrust and Priorities emphasize the strict enforcement of existing rules, regulations, and local forest policies governing Forestry, Wildlife, Mining, and NIPAS Acts, leading to resolute apprehension and prosecution of violators.

BUDGETARY REQUIREMENTS:

All the materials and other expenses to be incurred for the conduct of the training will be charged to the allotted Deputation fund. The CENRO Brooke's Point Technical Staff will serve as Resource Speaker and will coordinate with the other Resource Speakers from different offices and/or agencies and will be the facilitator and act as secretariat for the 3-day event.
