BACKGROUND

In 2012, the state mandated professional competitiveness and professional qualifications standards through E.O. No. 83, s. 2012 or the Philippine Qualifications Framework (PQF). In 2018, PQF was institutionalized by R.A. No. 10968 or the "Philippine Qualifications Framework Act". Further, in 2016, R.A. No. 10912 or the "Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Act" lapsed into law. CPD is also a requirement in most of the Professional Regulatory Laws of the regulated profession.

Since then, the enhancement of professional competitiveness was slowed down by various serious challenges such as, those in the political, economic, socio-cultural, technological, environmental and legal, and specifically climaxed by the pandemic.

We are in a pivotal shift from the pre-pandemic to the post-pandemic era. Professionals face challenges from various sources as the professional landscape constantly changes. The "glocal" concept is becoming more relevant in today's increasingly interconnected, integrated, and complex global and local perspectives in all fields of human endeavor. The fast-paced and constantly evolving nature of the global economy means that advancements in one part of the region impact economies and societies in other parts. A deep understanding of global trends and local contexts for professionals to stay relevant, competitive, effective, and successful brings us to the concept of "glocalization." It shows us how local and global forces are shaping professional work and creating new opportunities for professionals.

This year, we are holding the PPS12 with the theme: "THE FILIPINO GLOCAL PROFESSIONALS: RIDING THROUGH THE CREST OF CHANGE." We will bring together professionals from various disciplines, sectors, and backgrounds and to discuss and share insights on the latest global trends about the concept of glocalization.
