Agreement reached during the September 19, 2023 Meeting, held at Harolds Evotel regarding the Strategy for the Information Dissemination Campaign on the Masterlist of Land Area for Cities and Municipalities, to wit:

- 1. Invite representative/s from DILG (Regional DILG);
- 2. Dialogue with LGU Mayors: prioritize LGUs (three LGUs) and indicate timelines, LGUs under same province or by Province, or by mayor (by municipality);
- 3. Same format of presentation with the presentation re: Bulacan and Rizal boundary dispute (presentation will be furnished to Regions);
- 4. Copy of the 2001 Masterlist of Land Area and the Matrix of Comparison of 2001 and 2019 Land Area will be sent through emails of the different Regional Offices;
- 5. If LMB to join in the meeting, there must be an advance invitation to LMB at least 2 weeks before the meeting;
- 6. Informing all REDs about the information dissemination to LGUs. LMB to draft a Memorandum addressed to all REDs regarding the agreement of the meeting;
- 7. Study well the presentation to the LGUs and be sure to cite all the legal basis. Profile of the contested areas should be included in the presentation e.g. if there is a government project and others;
- 8. Furnish the presentation to LMB, a week before the meeting. There must be no leaking of information to the LGUs.

Two (2) possible options of the TWG to OCD on the issue of disputed areas:

- a. Not to include the contested area in the NTA computation;
- b. To equally divide the contested area among concerned LGUs
