AUTHORIZING THE CONDUCT OF WORKSHOP ON THE REVIEW/UPDATING OF TAMARAW CONSERVATION MANAGEMENT AND ACTION PLAN (TCMAP), ISLAND-WIDE TAMARAW PROTECTION AND LAW ENFORCEMENT, AND CONSULTATION OF FEASIBILITY STUDY ON TAMARAW TRANSLOCATION AND EX SITU MANAGEMENT ON OCTOBER 3-6, 2023

In the interest of the service and as part of the celebration of Tamaraw Month in October pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 273 Series of 2002, the conduct of a three-day workshop on tamaraw conservation in San Jose, Occidental Mindoro on October 3-6, 2023 is hereby authorized. Expenses during the workshop shall be jointly shouldered by DAF and DENR MIMAROPA, except for travelling expenses and per diems of DENR participants which shall be charged against their respective offices funds', subject to availability and existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations. An amount of P100,000.00 shall be downloaded by the Regional Office to PENRO Occidental Mindoro chargeable against Wildlife Resources Conservation Sub-Program as DENR's counterpart fund in the conduct of the activity.

The TCP Coordinator shall submit report to the undersigned within fifteen (15) days upon conclusion of the activity.
