TRAVEL REPORT: CONDUCT OF REGULAR LAWIN FOREST

AND BIODIVERSITY MONITOTING SYSTEM

In order to accomplished the target in 2023 Work and Financial Plan the undersigned conduct the regular LAWIN forest and biodiversity patrolling within the conservation area in Barangay Malinao and Barangay Kay Duke in Municipality of Torrijos, Marinduque.

Coordination with the concerned barangay was conducted prior to the actual foot patrolling. Syncing of conservation area into the gadgets is strictly observed to ensure that the patrolling is within the subject conservation area.

Through the course of foot patrolling, no threat was observed within the conservation area. CY 2015 NGP graduated plantation was patrolled and observed to be healthy and growing steadily which served as protection of the nearby communities during storm surge. Some portion of the mangrove forest patrolled is sparse but majority of the mangrove cover is dense. Community nearby is well aware of the policy of the government with regard to cutting if trees specially the mangrove trees.

A total of 2.94 kilometers and 0.87 kilometer of distance patrolled were accomplished within the conservation area of Barangay Malinao and Barangay Kay Duke, Torrijos, Marinduque, respectiviely, with the total of 3.81 kilometers of distance patrolled.




Forest condition within the Conservation area in Barangay Malinao, Torrijos which is moderate spare but consists of different species



Be informed further, that the team have coordinated with the concerned Barangay Local Government Unit before the conduct of patrolling and monitoring within their mangrove forest. After the coordination, the team proceeded to the target area. In our patrol route, the team found out that the mangrove forest is in good condition and monitored the established plantation of CY 2015 under National Greening Program (NGP) and found out that the mangrove species were found to be well-grown.

In our patrol route, no threats were recorded during the conduct of LAWIN patrolling and monitoring. On the other hand, the team have accomplished a total distance of 6.26 kilometers as an output of LAWIN patrolling activity on the said barangay.




Geotagged photos showing the mangrove forest of Barangay Buyabod, Sta. Cruz, Marinduque.
