SUBJECT : **REQUEST FOR TRAVEL AUTHORITY TO SINGAPORE TO PARTICIPATE IN REGIONAL CAPACITY BUILDING WORKSHOP FOR ASEAN FLYWAY NETWORK AND SITE MANAGERS ON SEPTEMBER 1-7, 2024**

With reference to the nomination from the Assistant Secretary for International Affairs and Concurrent OIC, Director Marcial C. Amaro, Jr. of Biodiversity Management Bureau (BMB) dated July 11, 2024 and to the Memorandum from the Executive Director Dr. Theresa Mundita S. Lim of ASEAN Center for Biodiversity (ACB) dated June 6, 2024 regarding the invitation to the *Regional Capacity Building Workshop for ASEAN Flyway Network and Site Managers*, respectfully submitting the request for Travel Authority to Singapore from September 1-7, 2024. The undersigned shall represent the Naujan Lake National Park (NLNP) in the said workshop.

Naujan Lake National Park (NLNP) is known for its national and international importance. The NLNP is recognized as: 1. Philippine Flyway Site of East Asia Australasian Flyway Site (EAAF062); 2. 1008th Wetland of International Importance to the Ramsar List in 1999 due to the presence of at least 10,000 wintering Tufted ducks (*Aythya fuligula*); 3. Protected Area under the initial component of the National Integrated Protected Areas System (NIPAS) Act of 1992 (R.A. No. 7586) as amended by the Expanded NIPAS Act of 2018 (R.A. No. 10038); 4. Conservation Priority Area; 5. Important Bird Area (IBA); 6. Key Biodiversity Area (KBA); and, 7. Asian Waterbird Census (AWC) site. Meanwhile, the Naujan Lake is the 5th largest lake in the Philippines. NLNP is a home to the endemic Philippine Duck (*Anas luzonica*) and Philippine Swampphen (*Porphyrio porphyrio*) as well as to the resident Wandering Whistling Duck (*Dendrocygna arcuata*) and Common Moorhen (*Gallinula chloropus*). With its lake, marshland/ swamp, Parang vegetation, freshwater swamp forest, secondary forest and man-made wetlands, NLNP is a roosting and feeding ground to different resident and migratory birds, and a habitat to other wildlife species.

Through the structured learning event of the ACB in collaboration with the National Parks Board (NParks), Singapore with the support of the Japan-ASEAN Integration Fund (JAIF), the participation to the Regional Capacity Building Workshop for ASEAN Flyway Network and Site Managers is essential as the undersigned will be further capacitated in managing wetlands of national & international importance and its dependent migratory bird species. By attending the capacity building workshop, the undersigned shall participate to develop a comprehensive guidelines for national training programs, and standardize the wetland and migratory bird monitoring practices which can be used in the formulation and/ or implementation of AWC, Biodiversity Monitoring System (BMS), Biodiversity Assessment and Monitoring System (BAMS), enforcement of environment and natural resources laws/ policies/ rules/ regulations and other Programs/ Activities/ Projects (P/ A/ Ps) in NLNP and wildlife. Meanwhile, the technical skills will be shared/ cascaded to the CENRO Socorro and NLNP-PAMO personnel after the learning event.





ASEAN REGIONAL TRAINING WORKSHOP ON MIGRATORY WATERBIRD AND WETLAND MANAGEMENT

19–23 August 2024 (online)
2–6 September 2024, Singapore

BACKGROUND

The ASEAN Network on Wetlands and Migratory Waterbirds Conservation (also known as the ASEAN Flyway Network [AFN]) was formally established in 2018 during the inception meeting and the first network meeting in Singapore for the Phase I project titled, *Improving Biodiversity Conservation of Wetlands and Migratory Waterbirds in the ASEAN Region (AFN Phase I)*. This phase focused on conducting baseline and biodiversity monitoring surveys of existing and potential flyway sites, as well as priority coastal areas.

Following the conclusion of Phase I in June 2020, the ASEAN Centre for Biodiversity (ACB), in collaboration with the National Parks Board (NParks) of Singapore and with support from the Japan-ASEAN Integration Fund (JAIF) launched AFN Phase II. This phase emphasises the sustainable management of wetlands to ensure continuity and sustainability of the initial efforts and outcomes achieved in Phase I. AFN Phase II is dedicated to maintaining an efficient network and enhancing the capacities of flyway site managers and various stakeholders in wetland management and migratory bird monitoring.

A key activity of AFN Phase II is the conduct of a regional capacity-building workshop for AFN national focal points and site managers. Scheduled on 19-23 August 2024 (online) and 2-6 September 2024 in Singapore, the ASEAN Regional Training Workshop on Migratory Waterbird and Wetland Management will serve as a training of trainers and prepare participants for the national capacity-building workshops that will subsequently be held in each ASEAN Member State.

OBJECTIVES

1. Capacitate the future trainers and conservation practitioners in managing wetlands and monitoring migratory birds
2. Develop comprehensive guidelines for national training programs
3. Standardise the wetland and migratory bird monitoring practices in the region
4. Sustain a well-functioning ASEAN Flyway Network

EXPECTED OUTCOMES

Capacity building for future trainers and conservation practitioners

- Development of comprehensive guidelines for national training programs
- Skills in designing and implementing effective training courses for waterbird and wetland conservation



Standardised monitoring practices

- Enhanced skills in identifying and accurately counting different waterbird species
- Improved ability to contribute to bird banding and monitoring projects
- Familiarity with Eas-Asian-Australasian Flyway (EAAF) monitoring protocols and Asian Waterbird Census (AWC) methodologies

Well-functioned ASEAN Flyway Network

- skills to participate in flyway-scale monitoring programs
- knowledge of international collaboration efforts for waterbird conservation
- learning from successful case studies and site visits



- Improved the Protected Area Office (PAO) operations and deliver the necessary structures, providing conducive dwelling for the PA rangers and staff arousing their interest and boosting their morale in the performance of duties (*9 structures so far, including bunkhouses, catchment tanks, hanging bridges and office building*). The funds utilized for the structures were generated either thru official request from the DENR or grants from funding partners. From a meagre allocation of less than a hundred thousand in the beginning of his tenure, the PAO until at present enjoys millions of pesos at its disposal.
 - Equipped the personnel with technical capabilities thru trainings and workshops in order for them to carry out task and assignments with outmost dependability.
 - Established good rapport with Other Government Agencies (OGAs) and LGUs and so far has attained their interest to actively participate in PA management.
 - Reconstituted the PAMB membership based on what is embodied in the DAO 28-2006 or the Revised IRR of NIPAS Act of 1992;
 - Ensured that all stakeholders are well informed about the objective and rationale of the PA, and has so far obtained Resolutions from eight (8) *Sangguniang Bayan* (SB) and two (2) *Sangguniang Panlalawigan* (SP) of Mindoro, manifesting support for the Proclamation of MIBNP as PA under NIPAS.
 - Earned the trust and confidence of the Indigenous Peoples (*Tau-buid and Buhid*) by involving them as actors rather than passive subjects in PA Management.
 - Both IP Groups have expressed intent to support the Proclamation of MIBNP as PA under NIPAS thru Resolution acknowledge by NCIP;
 - The IP leadership consented on delineating the areas for Traditional Hunting as part of Indigenous Community Conservation Areas (ICCA) Documentation;
 - Tribal Leaders are actively and freely participating in PAMB undertaking more than before
 - Strengthened the PAMB by providing guidance and accurate and transparent information regarding specific concern/problem to ensure appropriate policy intervention.
 - In his stint as PASu, the PAMB has enacted more than hundred (100) of Resolutions addressing specific management concern for the Park.
 - Work on making MIBNP an active ASEAN Heritage Park (AHP) and is now in progress of attaining another international recognition as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
 - Set MIBNP and stakeholders at work towards final Proclamation under the NIPAS.
- Summary of Actual Duties
 - Enforce rules and regulations to protect the area from trespassing, damage, vandalism and illegal occupancy
 - Issue permits for the use of facilities and amenities except for those considered as Special Uses

 - Issue Certificate of origin and/or transport permits for natural resources and other products collected/gathered from the protected area in accordance with the resource use instruments/agreements or gratuitous permits issued by the PAMB and/or the DENR;
 - Submit quarterly progress reports to the PAMB;
 - Serve as Head Secretariat to the PAMB and its Executive Committee;
 - Collect and/or receive pertinent fees, charges, donations and other income for the protected area. Such fees, charges, donations and other income collected/received is reported regularly to the PAMB in accordance with

the existing guidelines;

- Prepare and recommend to the PAMB approval of the annual work and financial plans of the protected area based on the Protected Area Management Plan (PAMP);
- Develop management information system to ensure that the relevant and updated information are available for planning, monitoring and decision-making; and
- Perform other relevant functions that the RED or PAMB may delegate
