COMPLIANCE MONITORING OF ONE (1) SOCIALIZED INDUSTRIAL FOREST MANAGEMENT AGREEMENTS (SIFMA)

AND GRATIUTOUS SPECIAL USE PERMIT (GSUP) HOLDERS

Respectfully forwarded are the attached Monitoring and Evaluation Forms, with enclosed sketch map and geotagged photos regarding the Compliance monitoring of one (1) Socialized Industrial Forest Management Agreement (SIFMA) holder in Brgy. Dampulan, Torrijos, Marinduque and the Gratuitous Special Use Permit (GSUP) in Brgy. Balogo, Sta. Cruz, Marinduque.

The SIFMA issued to Mr. Benito Albrando and the GSUP issued to Provincial Government of Marinduque were subjected to compliance monitoring.

Based on the assessment, Mr. Benito Albrando did not introduce any development nor improvement in the SIFMA. No maintenance nor any silvicultural activity conducted by the holders for the past years. On the other hand, the GSUP issued to Provincial Government of Marinduque is currently undergoing development. The holder through its contractor is conducting construction of pier and disposal of other dilapidated buildings and equipment in the area.

Per record, SIFMA issued to Mr. Benito Albrando was issued a Show-Cause Order dated December 09, 2022 from Regional Executive Director Lormelyn E. Claudio, *CESO IV*.





Purpose/s: <u>To conduct compliance monitoring of holder of Gratuitous Special Use Permit</u>

(GSUP) DENR MIMROPA-GSUP-2023-01 awarded to Provincial Local

Government Unit of Marinduque.

Improvements introduced in the area:

During the time of compliance monitoring, developments and improvements within the tenured area are still on-going.

Compliance to the Terms and Conditions of GSUP

The area granted in this Permit: (a) is a public forest land based on existing records; (b) shall not be involved in any private transaction.	Complied
The annual government share or user's fee is waived in favor of the Permittee.	Complied
3. The Permittee shall: (a) comply with the laws, rules and regulation and instruction now or hereinafter enforced for the proper use of the land; (b) respect any legal or prior claims (c) conserve the corners and boundary lines of the area; (d) protect any wetlands such as spring, waterfalls, peatlands, swamps, lake and marshes or natural/historical/archaeological sites in the area; (e) report to the nearest local forest	Complied

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	officer(s) all forest violations in the area and adjacent lands; and (f) submit a year-end, not later than March 30 of the succeeding year, to the concerned Regional Executive Director thru the CENRO/PENRO the kind, number and value of improvement(s) introduced in the area, among others.	
	The Permittee shall strictly adhere with Section 43 of Presidential Decree (PD) 705 (Revised Forestry Code of the Philippines) which state that the, "Swamplands and Mangrove Forests – strip of mangrove forest bordering numerous island/s which protect the shoreline, the shoreline roads, and even coastal communities from the destructive force of the sea during winds and typhoons, shall be maintained and shall not be alienated. Such strips must be kept free from artificial obstruction so that flood water will flow unimpeded to the sea to avoid flooding or inundation of cultivated areas in the upstream.	Complied
	The Permittee shall: (a) not appropriate for himself/herself the exclusive use of public trails traversing or adjoining the area or impede the use thereof by the public; (b) not sublease the area or any portion thereof; and (c) protect and conserve threatened, unique, rare and endangered trees/plants/wildlife identified under existing rules and regulations	Complied
6.	A separate permit shall be secured by the Permittee should tree cutting be necessary. However, no tree, regardless of species, shall be cut in the permitted area if found within forty (40) meters from the bank of rivers, creeks or streams and buffer strips. In case the said 40-meter strip is bereft of trees, the same shall be rehabilitated by the Permittee.	Not Applicable for this period as no cutting of trees within the area is conducted
	The Permittee shall strictly observe the terms and conditions of the ECC. 10. Non-use of the area within six (6) months after it is granted will result in the cancellation of the Permit except in case of force majeure or fortuitous events.	Complied

The GSUP for the construction of roads and bridges shall have a maximum non-renewable term of five (5) years and similarly, the GSUP for the construction and operation of schools, hospitals, health centers, flood control facilities, water reservoir or impounding dam and its related facilities, air strip, landing site, harbor, public market, public plazas and evacuations site shall have a maximum non-renewable term of five (5) years. The GSUP and its additional terms and conditions shall be approved by the RED.	Complied
14. Except the agencies permitted to construct roads and bridges, the other agencies permitted to construct and operate infrastructure projects or facilities for the public service and use shall apply for the issuance of Presidential Proclamation starting on the second year from the issuance of the GSUP to ensure effective management and sustainability of the infrastructure and facilities and its long term use of the area where the infrastructure exists. second (2nd) year to the fifth (5th) year of the GSUP, the Permittee shall apply for Forest Land Use Agreement (FLAG) pursuant to DENR Administrative Order No. 2004-59 dated 31 August 2004 and other related policies on special uses of forest lands.

Other findings:

- The construction of crane way was observed in the tenured area.
- Pile driving activity was also conducted by the Contractor.
- Some of the properties of the MARCOPPER Mining Corporation were already bid by the Provincial Government of Marinduque.
- Hazardous waste is still present in one of the storeroom.

Comments/Recommendations:

- To advise and require the holder to submit their Annual Report about their activities in the tenured area.
- To advise the holder to secure a Presidential Proclamation within the allowable period starting from the second (2nd) year to the fifth (5th) year of the GSUP, failing to avail PP within the prescribed period, the holder shall apply for Forest Land Use Agreement (FLAG) pursuant to DAO No. 2004-59.
- The holder shall maintain and protect the mangrove forest therein.
- The hazardous waste within the tenured area must be removed and cleaned
