This pertains to the Memorandum from the PENRO dated August 1, 2024 and immediately referred to by the CENRO per Memorandum dated August 2, 2024 regarding the above subject.

Please be informed that initial actions were immediately undertaken by ENMRPA PAMO regarding the Dugong sightings in our jurisdiction per submitted Memorandum dated August 1, 2024 from the PAMO staff and endorsed by the Officer In-Charge of the PAMO.

Further, as additional response on the incident at hand, the undersigned sent letters to Hon. Mayor Edna G. Lim, CG Jairene Lim of Philippine Coast Guard, and Ms. Elizabeth Panganiban of El Nido Pump Boat Owners and Operators Association (ENPOOA). Coordination with conservation partners, the Malampaya Foundation Inc. (MFI) and Ms. Mariglo Laririt of Ten Knots Philippines Inc. (TKPI) was also done and an Action Plan was crafted as a result of the coordination. The undersigned also issued Memorandum instruction to the ENMRPA Park Rangers with team to be led by Assistant PASu to investigate and gather relevant data and information and with specific directive to submit investigation report by 3:00PM today.

The undersigned will closely monitor actions taken by our Park Rangers and immediately inform the RED, PENRO and CENRO of anything important that would come up on this specific instruction.

In line with the urgent instructions from the Regional Executive Director regarding the Dugong sightings in our area of jurisdiction, the El Nido Managed Resource Protected Area (ENMRPA), ALL Park Rangers and lagoon marshals hereby directed to intensify sea borne patrolling and conduct diligent observations in our marine areas to detect marine mammals as well as all the marine resources we are protecting. Immediately inform our CMEMP Extension Officer, Mariel Paladan if there are observation for the preparation of spot report.

In this regard, the Assistant Protected Area Superintendent (APASu) will lead the team and the following ENMRPA Park Rangers will provide assistance on the conduct of investigation and gathering of relevant information such as location and other data pertaining to the recent Dugong sightings, to wit:
