SUBJECT: REVISED REGIONAL SPECIAL ORDER NO. 066 DATED MARCH 25, 2022 RE: AUTHORIZING THE GRANT OF INTERNET/COMMUNICATION ALLOWANCE TO MINDORO BIODIVERSITY CORRIDOR (MBC) PROJECT MANAGEMENT UNIT (PMU)

In the interest of the service and to ensure continuous and smooth operations of the Mindoro Biodiversity Corridor Project in compliance to various requirements of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) as the Implementing Agency and Implementing Partner, respectively, Regional Special Order No. 066 dated March 25, 2022 is hereby revised as follows:

- The internet/communication allowance and related expenses to be incurred in relation to the implementation of the project shall be charged against the BD Corridor Project funds subject to existing auditing and accounting rules and regulations.

- 4. Regional Special Order No. 066 dated March 25, 2022 is hereby repealed.
- 5. This Order shall take effect retroactively on January 1, 2023 and shall remain in effect until revoked in writing and/or upon project termination.
