## The team shall:

- 1) Conduct Communication, Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) to the concerned communities prior to the ground delineation.
- 2) Conduct ground delineation of the management zone (strict protection and multiple use zones) of MIBNP based on its Protected Area Management Plan (PAMP) approved by the Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) through their Resolution No. 2022-07 re Kapasiyahang Nagpapahayag ng Pagtanggap at Pag-apruba sa mga Nirebisang Nilalaman at Itinatadhana ng Planong Pamamahala (Protected Area Management Plan) ng Mounts Iglit-Baco Natural Park sa Loob ng Taong 2019-2028, and duly affirmed by the Undersecretary for Policy, Planning and International Affairs consistent with Rule 9.7 of DAO 2019-05.
- 3) Consider the following options on the ground delineation based on the result of CEPA and characteristic of the area:
  - a. Installation of 15cm x 15cm x 60cm fabricated markers on observed points relocated through Global Positioning System (GPS) instruments or other suitable survey instruments.
  - b. Strip planning with indigenous forest tree species and native flowering plants.
  - c. Installation of additional signage using materials that would blend with the natural setting but visible for public awareness and prevent encroachment.
- 4) Submit ground delineation report with map

All traveling expenses and per diems shall be charged against *Protected Areas, Caves and Wetlands Development and Management Sub-Program*, subject to the availability of funds, and existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order takes effect immediately and shall automatically deemed revoked upon submission of final delineation report to the BMB.
