Based on the report, the python was free from any injury and approximately eight (8) meters in length. After thorough inspection, it was immediately released back to the wild.

Respectfully submitting the report on the release of one (1) Reticulated Python (*Malayopython reticulatus*) back to the wild. The python was released on September 15, 2023.

Based on the report, Mr. Merben Lastica, a concerned citizen from Barangay Lumangbayan, San Teodoro, Oriental Mindoro, turned-over the Reticulated Python to this Office on September 15, 2023. The python was found in his chicken cage on September 4, 2023.

Based on the results of visual assessment of the receiving CENRO Socorro personnel, it was found out that the Reticulated Python has a length of approximately 8 meters. Further, it is free from any injury, pest and disease.

Reticulated Python is considered as *Category D: Other Threatened Species* (OTS) as per the DENR AO No. 2019-09 Updated National List of Threatened Philippine Fauna and their Categories. After the turn-over, the endangered species was immediately released back to the wild specifically to the forested part of the Municipality of San Teodoro, Oriental Mindoro.
