

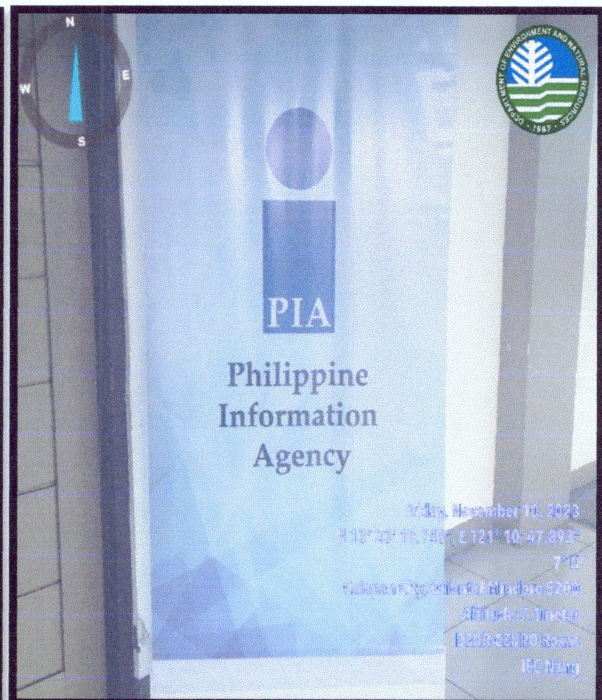

SUBJECT : REPORT ON THE ATTENDED 2ND ANNUAL MIMAROPA COMMUNICATORS NETWORK IN CALAPAN CITY, ORIENTAL MINDORO ON NOVEMBER 10, 2023

The Philippine Information Agency (PIA), is the information arm of the government mandated to provide accurate and timely information to the Filipino public. This office has been invited by the agency to attend their meeting on November 10, 2023, from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm, at the BFAR Building, located on the fourth floor in Guinobatan, Calapan City, Oriental Mindoro.





The meeting was participated by different agencies in the government. The meeting started with a prayer followed by the singing of the national Anthem. The presider called the OIC Regional Head of PIA MIMAROPA, Dr. Luis T. Cueto to give his welcome message. He gives emphasis on the effective communication clarifies information, helps build relationship, teamwork, and trust. *“Through us, we must fight fake news by telling the truth not just by sharing what we see on Facebook or*

other media platforms. Our role is to give people accurate, timely, and relevant information according to their needs”. This are the words of Dr. Luis T. Cueto.

The discussion started with the first speaker to talked about Unified Communication, Information Officer III, Acting Deputy Regional Head of PIA-MIMAROPA, Mr. Gene Ace Sapit. He discussed how can the government and society can curb misinformation, and to share the basic knowledge of unified communication. He defines unified communication as it refers to the integration of various communication tools and services into a single flatform to enhance collaboration and streamline communication processes. He discussed unified communication in government agencies, presidential communication office, key steps can be implemented in order to unify the communication in the regional government agencies like establish flatform, enhance communication efficiency, and regular training programs. To answer how can the government and society curb misinformation? The Presidential Communication Office (PCO) advised the public to report false information that they encounter in social media and refrain from sharing it. A practical guide for the public to adopt **STOP and SPOT approach**





will counter misinformation and disinformation. Stop to Spot: the source, the time, and the purpose. This approach is the simpler way of fighting fake news.

The second and last speaker was to share Effective Radio communication, Mr. Voltaire Dequina, Information Center Manager of PIA Occidental Mindoro. He gives some observations from his time working as a disk jockey. Dequina also underlined the value of information officers in terms of spreading and promoting news that is progressive. He went on to say that information officers had to take the lead in supporting government initiatives and activities that help the people. He discussed types of broadcasting performance, techniques, tips, and trends, and gave broadcast performance tips.



Following this action, it is anticipated that information will be seamlessly shared and disseminated throughout various national agencies and media partners, which will be essential in promoting proactive citizenship, national advancement, and a higher standard of living for Filipinos.
