This activity focused on the adverse effects of oil spill to coastal and marine biodiversity. Further effects of oil spill to human health were also included in the IEC.

SUBJECT : **SUBMISSION OF REPORT ON THE CONDUCTED IEC ON OIL SPILL IN THE MUNICIPALITIES OF MANSALAY AND ROXAS, ORIENTAL MINDORO ON NOVEMBER 17, 2023**

An oil spill can harm water, air, and land by destroying natural habitats. The production on continental shelves, petroleum exploration and transit in large boats have increased the cases of oil spill. It also affects the livelihood of our fisherfolks, fish vendors and the community.

This office spearheaded the conduct of information, education and communication (IEC) Environmental Lectures on fisherfolks, barangay officials and cash for work beneficiaries. The municipality of Mansalay was the first venue to conduct an IEC in relation to oil spill. That has impacted eight barangays, including Budburan, Sta. Poblacion, Sta. Brigida in Mansalay, Oriental Mindoro. It was participated by Barangay Official, Bantay Dagat, Barangay LGU, Fisherfolks and DENR personnel. A total of 60 participants, consisting of 27 females and 33 males based on attendance.

The activity started at 9:00 am led by Information Officer Nowena B. Joung MPA, and after that graced the event with his warm support of the activity by Barangay Councilor Franklin De Silva expressed his gratitude to the participant of the other barangay. Further, Ecoms II Engr. Jezreel John Matre discussed about Biodiversity and described the various types of plants, trees, flowers, animals, fungi, insects, and microorganisms. The tamaraw is one frequent illustration of the fauna peculiar to our area. To help the audience better comprehend the tamaraw's distinctive characteristics, a comparison between a tamaraw and a carabao was presented. And also discuss Marine Biodiversity the variety of life found in the ocean. It has It has variety of animals and spans a wide range of environment, from coral reefs. Because it contributes to ecosystem like oxygen production, climate management and food resources. It is essential to comprehend and protect marine biodiversity if life is to continue on Earth.

It was followed by Mr. Mark Aballos who is a Nurse by profession but serves as Admin Aide IV and a registered nurse by profession. He discussed the 2 kinds of exposure to an oil spill which can either be direct or indirect and short-term or long term. He said that if a person has direct contact with oil spill like sudden touch or swimming, that is direct exposure to contaminated water by an oil spill, this may result in skin irritation, confusion or memory

loss, dizziness and headache, sneezing, heavy breathing, and decrease of platelet. Direct long-term exposure to an oil spill that reaches almost 6 months may trigger those diagnosed with lung disease and skin allergies or worse it can lead to cancer.

After the activity the Information Officer Nowena B. Joung, MPA expressed her gratitude to the participants, especially the fisherfolks, and Barangay Officials for their commitment and support to the environmental activities this Office will still have.

In the afternoon, the DENR CENRO Roxas proceeded to conduct the same activity as the former in the municipality of Roxas. Four barangays were affected, namely Barangay Bagumbayan, Paclasan, San Isidro and San Jose in Roxas, Oriental Mindoro. It was attended by barangay officials, Bantay Dagat, Fisherfolk, Barangay LGU, and DENR personnel. It was composed of 8 female and 33 males, for a total of 41 participants.

The program began with a prayer delivered by Ecoms II Engr. Jezreel John Matre and expressed his gratitude to the barangay's participant. The first Speaker is Admin Aide VI, Mr. Dale Alagao discussed about Marine Biodiversity human activities like overfishing, pollution, climate change, and habitat destruction threaten this rich diversity. Conservation effort, marine protected areas sustainable fishing practices, and reducing pollution are vital to ecosystem. Also discuss Biodiversity it refers to the variety of life forms on Earth, that have different species of plant animals, microorganism and their ecosystems. It's crucial of our planet and sustains ecosystem that provide us with food, clean air, water medicines and numerous other resources essential for our life.

The last speaker is Mr. Mark Abalos who is a Nurse by profession but serves as Admin Aide IV, there he discussed the negative effects of oil spills on humans. The short-term and long-term negative effects were explained. According to him, an individual who comes into close contact with an oil spill that is, swims in contaminated water or is suddenly touched may have headaches and dizziness, sneezing fits, heavy breathing, and a drop in platelets. Direct long-term exposure to an oil spill for up to 6 months can aggravate skin allergies and lung diseases in people who have already been diagnosed with them, or even worse, it might cause cancer. After the discussion question and answer followed.

The activity ended with a message from Ecoms II Engr. Jezreel John Matre who expressed his gratitude to the participants, especially the Brgy. Officials and Barangay LGU for their commitment and support to the environmental activities this Office will still have.
