Cawit, Boac, Marinduque.

Based on the inspection/verification conducted by personnel of this Office, the said butterfly farm has a total area of 2,393 square meters situated within a private land identified as Lot. 1145-I, Psd-04-190003 covered with Transfer Certificate of Title No. T-7991, registered in the name of Ms. Elizabeth Lumawig Heitzman located in Brgy. Cawit, Boac, Marinduque.

In addition, based on the findings the cleanliness of flight cages purposely for mating and egg laying activities were maintained to prevent possible contamination and/or spread of pest/diseases which may affect the survival of both the captive and the wild population of butterflies in the area.

Considering that the applicant is technically trained and capable to pursue suitable development and conservation of butterfly, it is therefore recommended that the renewal of Wildlife farm and Collector's Permit (WFP/WCP) be granted in favor of Ms. Aubrey Heitzaman subject to existing forestry, law, rules and regulations.

I. BACKGROUND:

In Pursuant to the Provisions of Republic Act No. 9147 series of 2001, its implementing Rules and Regulations (Joint DENR-DA-PCSD Administrative Order No. 01-2004), and DENR Administrative Order No. 2004-55, the **ALH ENTERPRISE** represented by Ms. Aubrey L. Heitzman with an address at Barangay Cawit, Boac, Marinduque applied for renewal for Wildlife Farm Permit (WFP) and Wildlife Collector's Permit. Please be informed that the personnel of this Office conducted ocular inspection of the above-mentioned butterfly farm. Hereunder are our initial findings, to wit:

- ❖ Ms. Aubrey L. Heitzman has Wildlife Farm Permit No. MIMROPA-2016-0001 and Collector's Permit No. MIMROPA-2016-0001 issued on August 25, 2016 valid until June 30, 2020. The **ALH ENTERPRISE** is a business entity which aims to enhance conservation of local butterfly species through collection and captive breeding which contribute in the improvement of breeding techniques.
- ❖ During monitoring there was present of host plan such as: Tayngahan, Sili-Sili, Asahar, Guyabano, Tahid Labuyo, Kamote, Amoyong, Ivory, Basket basket, Lagaylay, Tapyas, Kaytana, Sinturis, Kalamansi, Lucban, Baging na Puti, Tapyas, Santol, Bayag Kambing, Kaytana, Hingiw na Itim and Dugtong ahas.
- ❖ According to the applicant, he is a member of International Association of Butterfly Exhibitors and she promote the international association to know about modern butterfly farming and systematic breeding. Furthermore, she shares her expertise on butterfly farming through a guest speaker.
- ❖ List of requirements submitted by the applicant in support to the Wildlife farm and Collector's Permit (WFP/WCP);
 - Duly Accomplished application form with recent 2x2 photo of the applicant (Annex "A");

III. COMMENTS AND OBSERVATIONS:


- ❖ Their butterfly farm's land with a flat topography, it is classified as agricultural land and planted with few bananas as well as a wide variety of local butterfly food plants.
- ❖ Flight cages purposely for mating and egg laying activities are clean properly maintained.
- ❖ Properly observed cleanliness and sanitation in the maintenance of farm facility to prevent possible contamination and/or spread of pest/diseases which may affect the survival of both the captive and the wild population of butterflies in the area.
- ❖ Ten percent (10%) of the total production of bred butterflies on was released for replenishment of the wild population.

Farm employees are two (2) local personnel from the barangay. Their daily task is maintain clean the farm facilities, planting foodplants and nectar plants, and breeding of butterflies.


IV. WORKING TIMETABLE/ASSUMPTION

- A. As common knowledge, the best known months for collecting insects fall on April to September and thus presumed that availability are butterflies are abundant viable for full breeding operation.

Catchers/breeders are told and trained
10% of the total production should be
released in the wild to maintain the
continuous supply of the butterfly
population, and do less with the “kaingin
system” and illegal cutting of trees.

VI. MANAGEMENT


Below is the chart flow for the Management activities taken of this

- B. Manner of collection would be based on butterfly traps, catching nets.
- C. . Problems commonly observed in the remote areas are “kaingin system” and illegal cutting of trees where some foodplants are associated and these can hamper the operation temporarily.
- D. To avoid butterflies being depleted in their natural habitat, it is recommended to select a forest area and re-introduce the butterflies to increase the stock.

VII. DEVELOPMENTAL PLAN

The butterfly facility should maintain cleanliness suitable for good quality breeding of progenies and to engage on the propagation of flowering and butterfly hostplants.

Project Description

The project is about captive breeding of butterflies in order to sale, trade and export progenies and re-introduction 10 % from the total butterfly production into the wild to maintain the existing wild population.

The breeding facility is located in the inner Barangay of Cawit, Boac, Marinduque. It is about 10 kilometers from Boac town proper. Most the residents are engaged in copra making, rice production, agricultural crops including bananas, rice, corn etc , hog raising and a big number of families are actively into butterfly breeding. There are about 40 households within 500 meter radius. Communication like Globe, Smart and PLDT , barangay hall, public elementary school and small stores are present.

Project Maintenance throughout its lifespan

Nets used for flying and breeding cages to last for at least 5 years, Bamboo poles can last for at least 2-3 years. Recommendation for replacement when typhoon season comes or longer if the structures can withstand natural disasters.


Source of Environmental Impacts

The whole land area is around 4000 sqm. There are 2 flight cages – a small one that is 40sqm, and a bigger one that is 90 sqm. Inside the farm is the Lumawig Museum. The farm is located in a lowland planted with various butterfly hosplants like Ipomoea batatas, Parsonsia, guabanos, calamansi, lemon, pomelos to name a few. There are already existing trees like papayas, bananas, bamboos and coconuts

inside the farm. No chemicals and solvents are used in the farm. Materials used in the construction of the facility and the cages will not generate any noise.

The project is environment friendly and provides employment and revenue to the families living in the barangay.

The permittee shall submit a report to the DENR through the Regional Director all collections made under the permit, including mortality indicating therein the quantity and species collected, places of collection, names and addresses of trappers/suppliers and such other information as the DENR requires;
4. All wild fauna collected by the permittee shall pass through the DENR-PENRO or CENRO nearest the place of collection for inspection and issuance of transport permit;
5. The names and addresses **of** trappers/collectors commissioned by the permittee shall be registered with the nearest DENR-PENR/CENR Offices;
6. In case of any intentions to conduct bioprospecting activities, such activities shall be subject to prior clearance and should be undertaken in accordance with the provisions of R.A. 9147 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations and other laws applicable thereon;
7. Any alteration, erasure or obliteration in this permit shall be a sufficient ground for the cancellation/revocation hereof without prejudice to criminal and other liabilities of the offender;



1. The permittee shall maintain and operate a wildlife breeding farm facility with an area of at least 4 sq. meters and height of at least 2 meters at Brgy. Cawit, Boac, Marinduque for butterflies that shall be granted under a Wildlife Collector's Permit for Breeding (WCP) by the DENR. Establishment of additional facilities should have prior clearance from the DENR through the Regional Director;
2. The permittee shall observe cleanliness and sanitation in the maintenance of the farm facility to prevent possible contamination and/or spread of pest/diseases which may affect the survival of both the captive and the wild population of butterflies, moth and other wildlife species in the area.
3. The permittee shall allow at any time any DENR authorized representative(s) to inspect and/or monitor the farm facilities or premises;
4. The permittee shall submit a periodic breeding report to the DENR through the Regional Director, for the accreditation of species bred within the farm. Further, ten percent (10%) of the total production of bred butterflies shall be released for replenishment of the wild population to be witnessed by representative(s) from local DENR Office. A certification to this effect by the CENRO or PENRO representative shall be submitted to Regional Office under Conservation Development Division and Licenses, Patents and Deeds Division which shall be one of the bases for renewal of this permit. Exotic species shall never be released into the wild except when authorized under pertinent rules and regulations and after issuance of an Environmental Compliance Certificate;
5. The permittee shall set aside at least 100 square meters for planting of food plants and continuously plant different species of host and food plants as much as possible to areas of collection where the 10% of the production of bred butterflies will be released;

6. Products or commodities using deadstock/preserved butterfly and moth specimens intended for trade should be properly tagged bearing the establishment's logo and stamp of DENR inspection. Corresponding serial number shall likewise be assigned to each of the items. The transport of butterfly specimens from one place to another within the country shall be accompanied by a Local Transport Permit to be secured from the nearest DENR Office;
7. Only bred species shall be allowed for trade. Species to be traded shall originate only from the farm permittee or from any of the registered breeding facility mentioned in Item No. 1;
8. In case of exportation of bred species, the permittee shall present the wildlife for export for inspection and verification by DENR. A Wildlife Certification shall be issued only upon satisfaction of requirements and payment of the required certification fee;
9. The permittee shall file his/her application for Wildlife Certification at least three (3) days before the intended date of shipment. A certification under oath stating the true export value of the fauna for export and copy of DTI Export Declaration shall be attached therein;
10. In case of request for re-issuance of Wildlife Certification, the original copy thereof shall be surrendered and the applicant shall apply for re-inspection of the wildlife species for export;
11. The permittee shall make a commitment in writing to pursue an Environment Conservation Program of his own or to be undertaken collectively with other permittees, to be signed by the permittee or by the highest official of the company, as the case may be. The permittee shall raise a total of 2,500 seedlings, a combination of host plants and forest trees within the period of this permit which will also be planted within the province with the assistance of the PENRO/CENRO concerned. Compliance to the commitment shall be one of the bases for renewal hereof;
12. In case of any intention to conduct bioprospecting activities, such activities shall be subject to prior clearance and should be undertaken in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act No. 9147 or other laws applicable thereon;
13. Any alteration, erasure or obliteration in this permit shall be sufficient ground for the cancellation/revocation of this permit without prejudice to criminal and other liabilities of the offender;
14. Failure to comply with any of the terms and conditions specified under this permit shall be sufficient ground for the immediate cancellation of this permit and disqualification from renewal;

15. This permit is non-transferable and shall be in force from date of issuance until **JUNE 30, 2021**, unless sooner revoked or cancelled for non-compliance with and/or violation of the terms and conditions specified in this permit, or for violation of pertinent laws, rules and regulations;





6. In case of any intentions to conduct bioprospecting activities, such activities shall be subject to prior clearance and should be undertaken in accordance with the provisions of R.A. 9147 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations and other laws applicable thereon;
7. Any alteration, erasure or obliteration in this permit shall be a sufficient ground for the cancellation/revocation hereof without prejudice to criminal and other liabilities of the offender;
8. Failure to comply with any of the terms and conditions specified under this permit shall be sufficient ground for the immediate cancellation of this permit and disqualification from renewal for a period of three (3) years from the date of violation;

9. This permit is non transferable and shall be in force from the date of issuance hereof until **August 30, 2021** unless sooner revoked or cancelled for non-compliance with and/or violation of the terms and conditions specified in this permit, or for violation of pertinent laws, rules and regulations;



WILDLIFE FARM PERMIT
(Butterfly Breeding Farm)

Pursuant with the provisions of Republic Act No. 9147 series of 2001, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (Joint DENR-DA-PCSD Administrative Order No.01-2004), and DENR Administrative Orders No.2004-55, **Ms. AUDREY LUMAWIG HEITZMANN (ALH Enterprise) of Brgy. 
