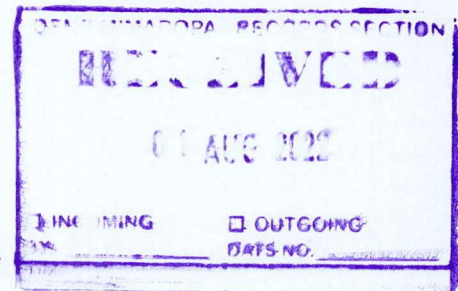

In compliance with the target activities for CY 2022, respectfully submitted is the Second Quarter Report on the formulation of Community Resource Management Framework (CRMF) and Five-Year Work Plan (FYWP) for the Community-Based Forest Management (CBFM) Area located in Brgy. Malbog, Buenevista, Marinduque, to wit:

CRMF formulation is a process composed of milestone activities. After the conduct of series of verbal and written coordination with the CBFM-PO, orientation of the PO members regarding the Forest Management Bureau (FMB) Technical Bulletin (TB) No. 20 or the *"Enhanced Guidelines and Procedures in the Preparation/Updating of the Community Resource Management Framework (CRMF) and Five-Year Work Plan for CBFMA"* and creation of PO Planning Team, another workshop for the next milestone activities were conducted on June 1 and 2, 2022. These include the identification of Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Challenges (SWOC); formulation of Vision, Mission, Goals and Objectives (VMGOs) and Market Survey. The activity was attended by twenty one (21) males and nineteen (19) females on June 1 while on June 2, there were 19 male and 21 female attendees.

The activity started with a short invocation. On the first day, before the workshop proper on the formulation of CRMF, an orientation on Gender and Development (GAD) was conducted. Forest Technician I Corazon R. Pelaez discussed about the objectives of GAD, the roles of women and their contributions in different aspect of the society as well as the rights and privileges of women and children in terms legality. After the discussion, the participants had different opinions about GAD and further elaborate the topics however, come up with a clear and common interpretation.

After the orientation about GAD, the guidelines on SWOC analysis and VMGOs formulation were discussed to the attendees. It was explained that there were four components to be considered in the activities such as Forestland (forest cover/resources), Organizational Development (social/community), Livelihood/Enterprise Development (individual/family, collective/communal) and Support Services needed by the PO (can be supported by OGAs/NGOs and other funding institutions). On the other hand, in Market Survey, all products locally produced in Brgy. Malbog, volume and frequency of production, nature of buyer, price and mode of payment were identified.

Following the discussion of each milestone activity, writing materials were given to the PO members to be used in the workshop. The prescribed tables indicated in FMB-TB No. 20 was also provided. After each activity, the attendees were given a chance to present their outputs for further discussion among the PO members.

The data/information gathered in the activity were collected and compiled by the facilitator's team for consolidation to be used in the preparation of the final draft of the CRMF.

Attached are the photocopy of attendance sheet and photos taken during the activity.
