SANCTUARY (UIGRBS) FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE 2022

Respectfully forwarded is the memorandum from CENRO Brooke's Point dated July 14, 2022 relative the above subject.

CENRO Brooke's Point submitted the report of the PASu of UIGRBS dated July 14, 2022 stating that the personnel assigned at UIGRBS are continuously doing the protection and conservation activities within and nearby areas of the PA. Likewise, coordination and linkages with other concerned law enforcement agencies are continuously strengthen to ensure proper implementation of ENR laws, rules and regulations.

Per report, disclosed a decreasing number of birds (Kamaso) for the month with total of 8,810 heads counted by the FPOs last June 26-27, 2022. Eight (8) heads of Marine Turtles (Green Sea Turtles) laid 754 eggs and transferred properly to the designated hatchery area. A total of 97 eggs of Marine Turtles successfully hatched this month and the hatchlings were properly guided to reach the seawater. (please refer to the attached detailed report for reference)

Likewise coordination and linkages with other law enforcement agencies was continuously strengthened to ensure that the existing laws, rules and regulations were implemented to protect and preserve the island's biodiversity.

Per report showed decreasing number of birds (*Kamaso*) for this month with a total counts of 8, 810 conducted by FPOs on June 26-27, 2022. There were also eight (8) heads of Marine Turtles (Green Sea Turtle) laid 754 eggs and transferred properly to the hatchery area and 97 eggs of marine turtle hatched this month and hatchlings were properly guided to reach the seashore.

## MONTHLY PROTECTION AND CONSERVATION ACTIVITIES WITHIN PROTECTED AREA

### **Activities Conducted:**

a. Monitoring of Marine Turtle Nesting Sites

The assigned Forest Protection Officers (FPOs) in the island conducted regular monitoring of the Marine Turtle Nesting Sites. There were 8 heads of Marine Turtles (Green Sea Turtle) that laid a total of 754 eggs and are transferred properly to the hatchery area to protect the eggs from wild nest predation and to increase the number of eggs to be hatched. Proper handling with extra care to eggs was applied and proper documentation with stick marking with stated number of eggs transferred and date of eggs laid was put beside the nest.

A total of 97 eggs of marine turtle hatched this month and hatchlings were properly guided to reach the seashore. (*Please see attached photos/documentation*).

### b. Monthly Bird Counting

Assigned FPOs conducted bird counting at the island in daily basis to monitor the number of birds specially Kamaso in the island. This month, they only counted for two (2) continuous days which had a total estimated counts of 8,810. According to the FPOs assigned in the island, the number of birds counted decreased because of the weather condition since starting this month rainy season comes and the birds cannot go out the island due to strong winds and rain and there is low pressure area during the time they counted.

Based on the report of the FPO, they had found baby Kamaso inside the UIGRBS forest area and they properly assisted and released it indicating that this month is also their nesting period so that they cannot go out the island. It can also prove that maybe the number of Kamaso counted decreased since the FPOs are counting the birds in flight not the birds staying inside the forest.

### c. Coastal Clean-Up

Assigned FPOs were also tasked to conduct coastal clean-up regularly. This month, they have collected 6 sacks of mix nonbiodegradable garbage such as plastic bottles, plastic bags, Styrofoams, nylons, ropes and rubbers in the islands shoreline together the Philippine Coast Guard Rio Tuba.

They also conducted hauling and disposal of the sacks of garbage to the mainland Bataraza.

### d. Monitoring of Tabon Birds Nesting Sites

FPOs hired by the DENR CENRO Brooke's Point with assistance from Blue Guards hired by LGU Bataraza conducted monitoring of Tabon Birds Nesting Sites within the forested area of the island. Nesting Sites monitored, recorded and documented.

### e. Seaborne/Foot Patrolling

The assigned FPO's major task is to conduct daily foot patrolling and/or seaborne patrolling within the vicinities of the island to detect any illegal activities that could cause harm to the wildlife living within the protected area including nearby marine areas. During seaborne patrolling, Fishermen ducking near the island's shoreline were investigated and oriented properly regarding the policies being implemented in the island and advised them to leave the vicinity of the island to avoid harm and disturbance to the wildlife.

### f. Other activities

1. On-going preparation of CEPA Materials (pamphlets, policy signages and wildlife signage).

PA Staff Mary Cris A. Ibañez had already printed one hundred fifty (150) UIGRBS Pamphlets. The distribution to concerned barangays Sarong, Taratak and Rio Tuba, Bataraza, Palawan was scheduled this 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> quarter simultaneously with the conduct of IEC together with the Enforcement Team. Policy signage and Wildlife signage was also prepared and production was targeted this 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter.

2. Preparation and Submission of Report of Ursula Island Game Refuge and Bird Sanctuary (UIGRBS) Second Quarter PAMB en Banc Meeting

PA Staff had prepared and submitted the Second quarter Report of UIGRBS PAMB meeting with complete attachments such as copy of Invitation letter and attendance sheet, Photo Documentation during the conduct of meeting, Approved 1<sup>st</sup> quarter PAMB Minutes of the meeting, Approved Resolutions and 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter draft PAMB Minutes of the meeting on June 20, 2022.

3. Continuous installation of mouse traps in the island

FPOs continuously conducting installation of mouse traps. No rats trap/retrieved since there were 2 cats temporarily deployed in the island as approved by PAMB Members during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter PAMB Meeting.

4. PASu Franklin Aquino and PA Staff Mary Cris A. Ibañez attended in the "Roll-out of NIPAS MPA Capacity Building for MIMAROPA Region" held at Asturias Hotel and Snake Island, Puerto Princesa City, Palawan on June 6-11, 2022.







Photo showing FPOs conducting seaborne and foot patrolling and disposal of garbage collected to the mainland Bataraza


