


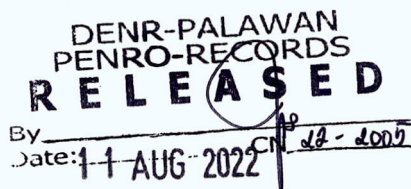

The incident was immediately reported to Sr. EMS Ma. Vivian O. Soriano of the Conservation and Development Section and was advised to turn-over the same to the Palawan Wildlife Rescue and Conservation Center (PWRCC) for proper rearing and disposition.

On the same day, the said wildlife species was turned over to PWRCC and the species identification was confirmed by the PWRCC personnel.

On or about 4:00 o'clock in the afternoon on July 16, 2022, staff of PNP Magarwak Station arrived at Sta. Lourdes Forest Product Monitoring Station bringing with them a snake with 1 ½ meter long and around 3 inches in diameter. According to the bearer, they found it at their training ground and they captured it using a sack.

The incident was reported to the CDS Chief Ms. Vivian Soriano, and she advised us to turn over the species to Palawan Wildlife Rescue and Conservation Center (PWRCC) in Brgy. Irawan, Puerto Princesa City for proper rearing. On the same day, it was turned over to PWRCC at around 5:40 in the afternoon. It was identified as Brown Tree Snake by the PWRCC staff.

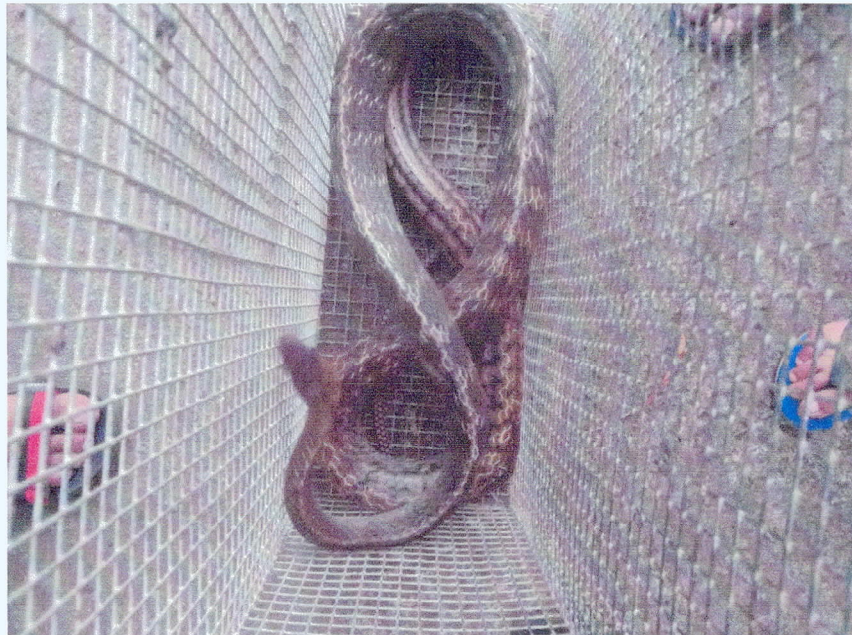
