#### I. INTRODUCTION

The Community-Based Forest Management (CBFM) is the national strategy for the sustainable development of the country's forest resources and social justice Pursuant to Executive Order No. 236 and Department Administrative Order (DAO) 96-29.

The Community Based Forest Management (CBFM) is the national strategy for the sustainable development of the country's forest resources. This program aims to promote the socio- economic upliftment of forest communities and achieving sustainable development and management of forest resources.

It recognizes the responsible and efficient utilization by organized and empowered local communities based on sound ecological and economic principles can result to sustainable management of forestlands and resources.

The periodic monitoring aims to know the status of the DENR-CARP Projects and other related CBFM activities within their respective areas in compliance with the existing rules and regulations, progress in terms of area development, organizational development and project implementation.

Part of the technical assistance provided to the CBFM partners during the periodic monitoring and assessment is the conduct of a small group of meeting with some BODs members of the association purposely to determine the extent of development undertaken within their respective CBFM areas. The result of the information provided during the meeting including the onsite monitoring and assessment will be the basis in providing them effective recommendations towards sustainable development management of their CBFM areas.

#### II. LEGAL BASIS

- 1. Under Executive Order No. 263, the Community Based Forest Management is a national Strategy to ensure sustainable development of the Country's Forestland Resources and providing mechanism for its implementation. Thus, the DENR is mandated to work with Local Government Units (LGUs), People's Organizations (Pos), Non-Government Organizations (NGOs), Religious Groups, Business and Industry sectors and other concerned organizations to ensure that communities are empowered to initiate and achieve the objectives of this Order (Section No. 6)
- 2. FMB Technical Bulletin No. 20 and Section 18 of DAO 2004-29, also indicates that the CRMF is a strategic plan of the community on how to manage and benefit from the forest resources on a sustainable basis. It describes the community's long term vision, aspirations, commitments, and strategies for the protection, rehabilitation, development, and utilization of forest resources. The CRMF shall provide specific activities for the first five (5) years, which shall serve as the Five Year Work Plan of the Peoples Organization.

A Community Based Forest Management (CBFMA) issued by the Regional Office in December 15, 1998, and to expire on December 15, 2023 under CBFMA Registration No RIV-OCCMIN-CBFMA-98-02 with 27 registered members.

In CY 2020, the CENRO Sablayan GIS Personnel conducted re-survey the 50 hectares awarded to **Barangay Farmers Association Inc.** 

The re-survey team submitted GIS maps in accordance with the FMB Technical Bulletin No. 21-A also known as the guidelines in the Assessment, Re-survey and Mapping of areas covered by CBFMA and other Tenure Agreement. Based on the result of the

assessment, resurvey and mapping of aforesaid CBFMA, the initial 50 hectares was adjusted into 54.7 hectares as the final and official area reported.

On February 20, 2019, a Memorandum from the Regional Executive Director Henry A. Adornado, PH D. informed this office regarding the approved CBFM- CARP Agroforestry and Livelihood Project for CY 2019 implementations. This is for the development of a thirty (30) hectares "Cashew Based Agroforestry Projects" within the fifty (50) hectares CBFM area with an amount of Six Hundred Twenty Eight Thousand Five Hundred (Php 628, 580.00) pesos as per Obligational Authority dated February 8, 2019. Consequently, a duly approved Work and Financial Plan of the project has been formulated indicating the schedule of payments/progress billing including retention and mobilization.

#### OBSERVATION/FINDINGS/COMMENTS

As per monitoring and performance evaluation conducted Last June 2, 2022, we observed the following:

- 1. That we observed some planted perennial agri-crops and fruit trees such as cashew and jackfruit, mango and coconut. Indigeneous species like Red lauan and Narra, exotic trees like Gmelina and Non-timber forest products like Rattan and Bamboo were also seen in the area.
- 2. That harvestable Gmelina and felled trees due to the previous typhoon were seen in the area. There are some illegal cuttings of Gmelina trees. However, when the PO Chairperson Harold Castillo was asked regarding the said cutting, he was unaware of such.
- 3. It was observed that no technologies were used to sustainably manage the areas designated for particular use.
- 4. It was also revealed that no benefit sharing scheme was ever present since the Coffee and Cashew-Based Agroforestry Project CY 2019 was implemented by the PO.




