In compliance to the PENRO memorandum dated May 31, 2022 with subject "Program Projects and Activities under ASEAN Heritage Park (AHP) Initiatives and Biodiversity Conservation and Management of Protected Area in ASEAN (BCAMP) projects for CY 2022 of Mts. Iglit-Baco Natural Park", submitted herewith is the progress report as of June 2022 for the target activities of MIBNP under BCAMP Project.

**Biodiversity Conservation and Management of Protected Area in ASEAN  
(BCAMP) for MIBNP**

***a. Capacity Building of PAMO staff, PAMB members and stakeholders***

The MIBNP-PAMO conducted the Workshop for Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) members and Stakeholders on March 10 to 11, 2022 under the Involvement of Indigenous and Local Communities-Output 1, 3 and 4 of Work Financial Plan CY 2022. The workshop was done through a "hybrid" modality and was attended by thirty-three (33) participants (22 face to face and 11 virtual via Zoom application), considering that some participants are from outside of Occidental Mindoro. The event was hosted by MIBNP-PAMO staffs and facilitated by Mr. Ronet B. Santos, Program officer of D'Aboville Foundation (DAF).

A Wildlife Enforcement Training for MIBNP staffs and stakeholders based on the approved revised BCAMP Work and Financial Plan was scheduled on 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter of CY 2021. The Terms of Reference (TOR) and activity design were submitted to BCAMP focal person and BMB (attached). A signed request letter from Office of the Regional Executive Director-

MIMAROPA (attached) was submitted to BMB requesting for resource person for the said activity. The training is rescheduled on July 18-23, 2022. Drafting of Special-Order preparation is ongoing.

***c. Popularization of Protected Area Management Plan (PAMP)***

The final version of PAMP was submitted to Biodiversity Management Bureau (BMB) on July 4, 2022 along with the updated resolution no. 2022-07 for the revised Protected Area Management Plan (PAMP). Moreover, the popularization of PAMP will only commence upon its approval.

***d. Ecotourism Management Planning***

The Ecotourism Site Profiling, activity design and full proposal of Ecotourism Management Plan (EMP) was submitted to ACB-BCAMP focal last April 27, 2021. Please be informed that the preparation of EMP is anchored to the PAMP and therefore will only officially commence once the PAMP is deemed approved.

***e. Preliminary activities leading to the ejectment and resettlement of illegal ranchers outside PA***

Based on the presented phase out plan on the ranchers, on January to June of 2022 there should have 50% livestock pulled out and up to December it should be 100%. On the updated inventory of the ranchers from 2021 up to the updated inventory on May 11, 2022. Out of 28 ranchers, 5 of them have already pulled out their cattle, representing a total average of 40%.


The preparation and presentation of relocation plan to PAMB is ongoing. The finalization and presentation of relocation plan to the stakeholder's ejectment agreement is also currently being prepared and will be scheduled for review of PENRO and PAMB members of MIBNP.

***f. The establishment of two model communal and agro-forestry farm for food security (community organization/strengthening)***

On establishing communal forest, two (2) sites have been surveyed and identified. The first site is in Tamaraw Genepool Farm, Brgy. Manoot, Rizal and the second is in Tamisan II, Brgy. Poypoy, Calintaan. The first site is scheduled for survey and delineated (*please see attached map*). The second site is scheduled for survey and delineation in 3<sup>rd</sup> week of July 2022. Nurseries for both sites are also being established. The establishment of communal forest will be based on eNGP guidelines.
