SUBJECT : INVENTORY OF IDLE GOVERNMENT LANDS FOR HOUSING SETTLEMENTS

DATE :

This is in relation to the high-level policy consultation on land administration and management issues and orientation on Republic Act No. 11573 conducted last April 26-28, 2022 at Boracay Island, Malay Aklan.

In the said consultation and as instructed by the Undersecretary for Legal, Administration, Human Resources, and Legislative Affairs, Atty. Ernesto D. Adobo, Jr., it was agreed that all DENR Regional Offices shall conduct an inventory and ground verification of government lands suitable for housing settlements as requested by other national government agencies. The inventory shall cover the following: (1) lands proclaimed as Housing Sites; (2) Government Owned Lands covered by Proclamations indicating the use; and (3) lands proclaimed as Civil/Military Reservations.

In view thereof, may we request you to submit to this office the summary report on the matter for consolidation, the soonest time possible.
