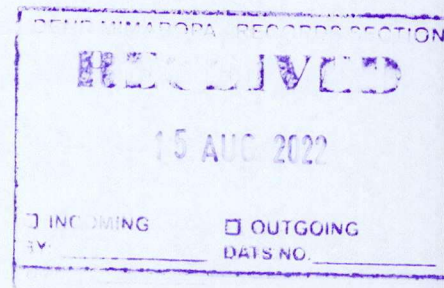

This pertains to the attached electronic mail of Mr. Keith Anthony S. Fabro dated 12 April 2022, requesting forestry/CBFM-related data from the Bureau. This Office had already provided Mr. Fabro the total number of CBFMA holders and total CBFMA area (hectares) based on the Philippine Forestry Statistics 2020, which currently serves as the official reference for numerical facts/data on the Forestry sector. Further, the status of the proposed Sustainable Forest Management Act was also given to Mr. Fabro.

On the other hand, considering that the other data being requested are not available within the Bureau, may we solicit your inputs on the following:

1. *Amount of DENR funds allocated for CBFM-related activities for the period of 2018-2022*

Please note that any DENR funds utilized to benefit our CBFMA holders (e.g. intended for the formulation of Community Resource Management Framework and Five-Year Work Plan, and conduct of monitoring and assessment/evaluation of CBFM Agreement) can be considered as CBFM-related funds. Exclude all data related to CBFM-CARP and NGP as such are already available in this Office.

2. *Assistance provided to CBFMA holders affected by Typhoon Odette (Rai)*

These include efforts to rebuild forest communities, particularly typhoon-affected CBFM People's Organizations (POs), and restore/improve their facilities, livelihood and living condition, including endeavors to reduce future disaster risks. CBFM-CARP-funded projects/activities which also served as part of or instrumental in the rehabilitation and recovery efforts can be included.

Matrices for the requested data are attached to be filled out by the Regions. We will appreciate receiving your responses on or before 10 June 2022, for eventual consolidation of the Community Forestry Section (CFS) of our Forest Resources Management Division. Greetings!

My name is Keith Anthony Fabro and I'm a freelance environmental journalist who regularly writes for independent news outlets like Mongabay, The Business Mirror, and Rappler.

Currently, I'm working on a Mongabay story featuring the Macatumbalen Community-Based Forest and Coastal Management Association, a nationally awarded CBFMA holder PO in San Vicente town in northern Palawan.

The 1,800+ article puts a spotlight on the PO's reforestation and forest-based enterprises initiatives before and after the Typhoon Odette. At the same time, it will highlight CBFM and NGP as among the Philippines' EbA strategies.

Relatedly, I am humbly requesting the following CBFM national data from your office:

- Total number of CBFMA holder POs and participating households
- Current CBFM area coverage vis-a-vis target area coverage
- Total budget for CBFM vis-a-vis FMB budget (2018-2022)

With the CBFM annual budget allocation from GAA, how do you help typhoon-hit CBFMA holders restart their reforestation efforts, as well as their community enterprises? What CBFM and/or NGP incentives are available to these POs to facilitate their recovery?

Additionally, may I know the status of the proposed Sustainable Forest Management Act? How long have you been working on the passage of this national policy and how will it specifically benefit CBFM and participating POs amid climate change?

I hope to include your responses in the first draft that I'm going to submit to my Mongabay editor, Isabel Esterman, next Friday (April 22). Thank you very much for your assistance.

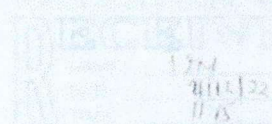

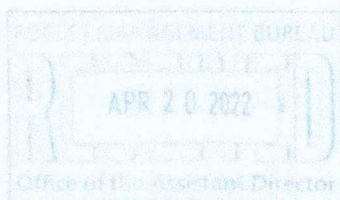
