

This pertains to the target 001 Patrolling under Maintenance and Protection of Coastal and Marine Ecosystem for El Nido-Taytay Managed Resource Protected Area (ENTMRPA), El Nido, Palawan.

Please be informed that the undersigned along with Forest Technician Voltaire Delos Angeles, Forest Ranger Jonathan Arzaga, Forest Ranger Francis Bose and rangers of the two protected areas conducted joint seaborne patrol within the jurisdiction of El Nido-Taytay Managed Resource Protected Area (ENTMRPA) and Malampaya Sound Protected Landscape and Seascape (MSPLS) having covered a total patrol distance of 116.038 kilometers (39.373 km in ENTMRPA and 76.665 km in MSPLS) based on locus map tracking and GIS projection .

The patrol starts at about 11:47 in the morning of July 14, 2022 at Divers House, Barangay Corong-corong, El Nido, Palawan. At about 12:16 am, the team rescued one (1) motor boat off the coast of Barangay Bebeladan due to engine failure and towed to Barangay Liminangcong.

At the team proceeded at Tumbod Ranger Station of MSPLS at about 1:37 in the afternoon and continued surveillance and monitoirng on possible illegal activies within the MSPLS Inner and Outer sound till 6:30 in the afternoon of July 15, 2022. On the way to the station, the team traversed the coast of Barangay Bebeladan, Pangulasian Island and Entalula Island.

The patrol ends at about 7:17 in the evening of July 15, 2022.




