This report is being submitted to serve as MOV for the aforesaid target activity.



This pertains to the target activity on the Maintenance and Protection of Coastal and Marine Ecosystem (e.g. reduction of threats and enforcement) - Conduct of regular habitat survey under 001 Management of Coastal and Marine Resources/Areas of Malampaya Sound Protected Landscape and Seascape (MSPLS), Taytay-San Vicente, Palawan.

Please be informed that this Office identified the monitoring of corals, mangroves and seagrass as the regular habitat survey for threats and pressures of illegal activities however no illegal activities were observed during the conduct of monitoring on the 1st quarter of CY 2022. Thus, this Office recommends to continuously conduct the regular habitat survey and intensify the Communication, Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) campaign to the Barangay LGUs in strengthening the law enforcement activity within MSPLS.
