Pleased be informed that on June 08, 2022, PAMO-RIWS personnel conducted coastal clean-up activity in the coastal area of barangay Panacan II, Narra, Palawan together with the fisherfolk and barangay officials in the area. This activity conducted was in line to the celebration of World Ocean's Day with a theme of "Revitalization: Collective Action for the Ocean".

During the conduct of the activity, a total of 11 sacks of garbage were collected weighing more or less 65 kilograms. The PAMO personnel observed that most of the garbage found in the shore were not drifted by sea waves but rather left/throwed by the community living in the area and most of it were partially buried in the beach sand having a hard time in collecting and causing the weight heavier than the usual. Upon observing, the littering was mainly because of the lack of the discipline of the community, lack of MRF facilities and Lack of implementation of "Tapat ko, Linis ko" Municipal ordinance pursuant to RA 9003, The Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000.

After the clean-up, APASu Bautista explained to the fisherfolk the importance of this activity. He oriented the community why this activity was conducted, what are the role of the community and what will we achieved by conducting this activity.

Herewith the list of most collected waste/garbage in the area:

1. Plastic bottles
2. Ice Case plastic bags
3. Rice sacks
4. Styrofoam Ice box (pieces)
5. Facemask
6. Junk food/Biscuit wrapper
7. Lumber debris
8. Coconut shell
