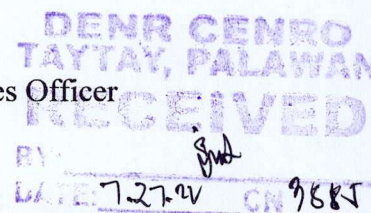




In relation to the World Mangrove Day celebration, please be informed that on July 26, 2022, this Office and the assigned personnel at Park Ranger Station conducted the simultaneous mangrove clean up on the abovementioned barangays.

A total of 6.5 kg of garbage consist of .5 kg of plastic bottles, 7 kg of assorted plastic bags and candy wrapper, .3 kg of rubber (i.e. slippers) and .5 of bottles (liquor) was collected and properly segregated at Barangay Old Guinlo, Taytay, Palawan. Likewise, a total of 15 kg of garbage consist of 8 kg of plastic bags and 7 kg of plastic bottles was collected and properly segregated at Park Ranger Station, Barangay Tumbod, Taytay, Palawan. The said garbage was properly disposed in the designated Material Recovery Facility (MRF) of the mentioned barangays. The activity was participated by three (3) females and seven (7) males.

The undersigned recommends the regular conduct of Communication, Education and Public Awareness (CEPA) campaign to the Barangay LGUs in coordination with the partner agencies regarding the Republic Act 9003 known as Ecological Solid Waste Management (ESWM) and the importance of mangroves and its vital role in the well-being, food security and protection of coastal communities.

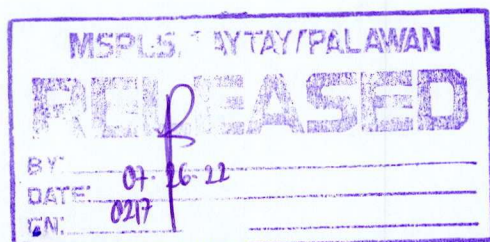
