1. EVALUATION OF THE COURSE:

Technical Content:

The objectives of the training-workshop are:

- 1. Provide field managers with the skills to effectively identify and monitor seabirds;
- 2. Identify target sites for seabird monitoring in the Philippines in 2023.

On the 3 days training-workshop the topics that were discussed are:

- 1. What are Seabirds their habitat, distribution, general characteristics and species in the Philippines;
- 2. Identifying seabirds on their behavior and description;
- 3. Basic rules of seabirds survey and research (Data gathering, Census and monitoring survey protocols); and
- 4. Action plan presentation and workshop for sites and presentation of output per Region.
- Impression/Comments:
 - 1. All topics are very interesting especially the presenter was undoubtedly shared to the participants of their expertise.
 - The main limitations in attending training-workshop via zoom were the poor internet connectivity and interruption of power supply during the lecture which can turn away the focus of the participants.

II. RELEVANCE OF THE LEARNING EVENT TO PARTICIPANT'S WORK/FUNCTION:

PAMO Staff has observed/spotted different types of seabirds species in Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary during regular patrolling but, the main problem was that we have no capacity to identify and no HD camera used in that particular activity. Hence, the 3 day learning event is relevant in our day to day monitoring and patrolling.

III. RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Face to face training and actual seabirds identification;
- Issuance of HD camera with telephoto lens intended for birds identification; and
- Fund allocation.
