COMPLIANCE MONITORING ON COMMUNITY-BASED FOREST MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT IN SAN FERNANDO, EL NIDO, PALAWAN OF SAN FERNANDO AGROFORESTRY

PRODUCERS COOPERATIVE

This pertains to target 001 Compliance Monitoring of Community Based Forest Management Agreement and STO Conduct of Monitoring and Validation of ENR Programs and Project of this Office. The team is respectfully submitting the result of the conducted monitoring last July 14-15, 2022, with a corresponding 100% accomplishment in COMPLETE STAFF WORK (CSW) format.

The activity disclosed the monitoring and evaluation of the performance of the holder of the CBFM Area based on the terms and conditions stipulated in the agreement and performance evaluation sheet for forestry tenure. Wherefore the findings and observations of the team are hereby enumerated as follows;

- 1. That pursuant to Executive Order No. 263 adopting the Community Based Forest Management Program (CBFM) as national strategy to ensure the sustainable development of the country's forestland, gave a positive response to address poverty and ensure sustainable management of resources, the San Fernando Agro-Forestry Producers Cooperative is one of the beneficiaries.
- 2. That on November 6, 2001, the DENR represented by Raymundo D. Crisostomo, OIC PENRO awarded CBFMA with No. RIV-PAL-CBFMA-2001-20, a total of one thousand three hundred seventy-eight (1,378) hectares to San Fernando Agro-Forestry Producers Cooperative formerly San Fernando Multi-Purpose Cooperative represented by Chairman Pedro R. Baguna, Jr. located in Barangay San Fernando, El Nido, Palawan.
- 3. That to present, the SFAFPC had a total of 25 members, composed of 12 male individuals and 13 females headed by PO Chairperson Adelina U. Sado.
- 4. That on the year May 28, 2018, the holder was awarded the Comprehensive Agrarian Reform Project (CARP) titled "Forest and Fruit Trees with Bamboo Plantation Project" and completed in the year 2020. Under the project, the holder raised and planted different commodities such as Dragon Fruit, Coffee, Guyabano, Cacao, Rambutan, Kakawate, Ipil-ipil and Banana intercropped with Pineapple and vegetable crops.

- 5. That the holder is also a beneficiary of National Greening Program (NGP) in the year 2011, 2012, 2013, and 2015 where they produced and raised indigenous trees such as Narra and Ipil. They also planted Bamboo, Coffee, Cashew, and Cacao. Aside from the above-mentioned projects, the holder also established and managed a sari-sari store.
- 6. That on July 14-15, 2022, the Compliance and Monitoring Unit staff conducted the compliance monitoring of San Fernando Agro-Forestry Producers Cooperative in Barangay San Fernando, El Nido, Palawan.
- 7. That issues and concerns during monitoring are observed, to wit:
  - Nursery is not fully maintained by the holder;
  - Lack of maintenance on the graduated CARP and NGP projects;
  - No existing facilities for the operational activities of CBFM; and
  - Willingness and dedication of the members to the Cooperative.

In view of the above findings and observation, the following are recommended, to wit;

- The holder should maintain and manage their nursery and continue to produce seedlings for the replacement of mortality;
- Encourage the beneficiaries to maintain the commodities/plantation;
- The cooperative should establish facilities for the operation of CBFM;
- Review and update their organizational structure; and
- Provide capacity building/training to the cooperative.

Be informed further that, on August 1, 2022, Chairperson Adelina U. Sado was informed through a letter informing the comments and observations during the compliance monitoring over the area of the Community Based-Forest Management (CBFM). Thus, the above-mentioned issues and concerns will be tackled in the incoming SFAFPC monthly meeting.


