This pertains to the letter dated July 20, 2022 and received by this Office on July 26, 2022 of Nagkakaisang Tribu ng Palawan (NATRIPAL) concerning the above subject.

Please be informed that on July 28, 2022, this Office attended the abovementioned activity initiated by NATRIPAL staff and participated by Barangay LGU of Abongan, Alacalian, Bato, and Calawag, NCIP personnel from Roxas, Barangay IPMR of Alimanguan, San Vicente, Municipal IPMR of San Vicente, and Indigenous People Leaders from San Vicente and Taytay, Palawan.

The topic discussed was the Republic Act 8371 otherwise known as Indigenous People Right Act (IPRA) presented by Ms. Ivy Kathryn A. Aborot, NCIP representative informing the participants about their rights in their ancestral domain particularly the four (4) bundles of rights stated in the IPRA Law, identified as Right to Ancestral Domains and Lands, Right to Self-Governance and Empowerment, Right to Social Justice and Human Rights and Right to Cultural Integrity. Likewise, she also mentioned about the advisory from Mr. Allen A. Capuyan, NCIP Chairperson regarding the National Advisory No. 2021-08-001, Series of 2021, whereas the Section 5 of RA 8371 states that "*Ancestral domains (ADs) are the ICC's/IP's private but commonly property which belongs to all generations and therefore cannot be sold, disposed or destroyed*". Meanwhile, the Protected Area Superintendent (PASu) Clarissa P. Pador presented the background of MSPLS particularly the total area covered, the twenty-two (22) barangays within the jurisdiction of MSPLS and PAMB Resolution No. 13, Series of 2013 declaring the Irrawaddy Dolphin as flagship species of MSPLS and brief discussion on ENIPAS.

Further, during the open forum an issues and concern was started with a question from Barangay IPMR Villamor R. Flores of Alimanguan, San Vicente in which he asked on what can be done to the IPs who sold an ancestral land to a non-IPs. The said question was answered by Hon. Johnmart M. Salunday, President of NATRIPAL and City IPMR of Puerto Princesa City, he said that based on the Joint Memorandum Circular of the DENR and NCIP, it was punishable in the amount of P 12,000.00 to P 500,000.00 and 1 year to 2 years imprisonment and the said sale is considered null and void. Then, Hon. Reynaldo Rodriguez, Municipal IPMR of San Vicente added that, it is necessary to raise such matter to the Barangay IPMR and if it is not resolved, submit a formal complaint to the NCIP to be discussed. PASu Pador, also informed the body, that if there are cutting of trees and kaingin making, it is also punishable under PD 705, Section 77 and 78 and reiterate to provide a copy of map regarding the land owned and claim by the IPs at Barangay Abongan, Taytay, Palawan. Hon. Salunday clarifies that the land claimed by the IPs is not based on the political boundary of a Barangays but on the National Boundary provided with



legal documents and based on the old Native Title. Likewise, Barangay Kagawad Daniel M. Gabinete asked question on how the Protected Area recognizes the traditional practices of the IPs, PASu Pador answered that the ADSDPP and PAMP of MSPLS are always together that recognizing the rights of IPs. A follow question from Hon. Gabinete, clarifying about the issue of demolishing the household within the coastal areas in which some of the IPs are residing, PASu Pador answered that the DENR does not have an authority to demolish a houses within coastal areas but this is the mandate of the LGU, she also informed the body that based on Presidential Decree No. 1067 known as Water Code of the Philippines particularly the legal easement and DENR Administrative Order No. 2021-07 states that no one should live in easement/coastal areas, because according to this law there must be a distance of 3 meters if it is an Urban areas, 20 meters for Alienable and Disposable areas and 40 meters for Timberland/Forestland from the highest tide. It is also necessary that in the ADSDPP the legal easement will be included not only the livelihood and the residential areas. Moreover, Hon. Rodriguez informed the body regarding the issues of 25 household of IPs residing at Sitio Ibangley raised by Barangay Kagawad Wilma J. Capuno of Abongan, accordingly he had a short conversation with Hon. Capuno about the possible solution on the matter in which the Barangay Abongan can listed the 25 household of IPs in their registered inhabitants for the benefits that can be received from the Barangay but they should cancel their household registry at Barangay Alimanguan, meanwhile when it comes to the benefits that will be provided for the IPs they will still receive it from Barangay Alimanguan, he also emphasized that the IPs are not forced to change their registration in the COMELEC and that matter is still based on the decision of the IPS.

Moreover, it was also discussed about the dialogue held in May 2022 with the IPs residing at Sitio Ibangley, whereas PASu Pador mentioned about the fallen/uprooted trees cause by Typhoon Odette that were marked by the inspection team and ordered not to move or reduce any of it, even those houses near the river as well as those who were making charcoal. Hon. Rodriguez, agreed with the statement of the PASu Pador and added that, he himself begged the IPs not to construct a new house and if possible the household near the river should be 50 meters away in the river. Then, Hon. Salunday, conclude about the DO's and DON'T's of an IPS such as no structure of houses near the river, no cutting of trees, selling of land to non-IPs and the BLGUs, NATRIPAL and PAMB will work together in relation to the residence of non-IPs in the ancestral claims but when a non-IPs bought a land in an ancestral claims they can rent the place with corresponding collateral however it will be the decision of the IPs if they will adopt this proposal or not it is the case in West Coast, Puerto Princesa City.

On the other hand, Hon. Flores asked also a question about the residence of IPs in Sitio Ibangley, for example that no one else is allowed to enter in their ancestral claims, what if their children get married or even give birth themselves? Where will they be put?. Then, PASu Pador, answered, that a plan is required because the area that currently occupied by that IPs is not suitable, it should be check if that IPs are included in the survey conducted by PAMO-MSPSL Staff on CY 2018 and also on where they can be properly settled. Likewise, Hon. Salunday, mentioned that "kaingin" is prohibited even in IPs especially by using a chainsaw because kaingin making in traditional practices uses a "gulok" and "palakol".

It was also discussed about the securing of NCIP Clearance/Certification of a proponent when applying a project whether within Protected Area and outside the Protected Area, Ms. Aborot clarify that when a proponent has a project in a Barangay and requesting a NCIP Clearance/Certification, it is necessary to coordinate with the NCIP Office for a requirements to be complied by the proponent before proceeding to Barangay for a Resolution, he stressed out that the Barangay and IPs Leader shall not give the proponent the resolutions until the NCIP has been coordinated. Hon. Salunday, mentioned also about a certification issued by the Barangay Officials based on the question of Barangay Kagawad Bren Ree T. Brillo of Barangay Abongan regarding to those person who bought a land in an ancestral claims, he said that the BLGU can issue a Certification on the actual occupant but not on the selling of land and the non-IPs has no

right over the ancestral claims, he also informed the body that when a project whether Government or Private is constructed inside the ancestral domain with title but outside Protected Area, the proponent may opt to applied for Usufruct Agreement.

The membership of the Protected Area Management Board (PAMB) was also discussed in which Hon, Salunday asked question about the representation of Indigenous People in the board, PASu Pador answered that the PAMB member was based on the composition in the RA 11038 or ENIPAS Act of 2018 where the NCIP is not included but at least one or more IPs representative from a municipality where the Protected Area is located.

The dialogue disclosed about the question of Hon. Gabinete regarding their petition on the exclusion of a portion of land in Barangay Alacalian based on the conducted Protected Area Suitability Assessment (PASA) of MSPLS, PASu Pador answered and clarifies that the submitted position paper of their Barangay with various reason will be the basis of whether an area needs to be excluded from the Protected Area and it will subject for a validation based on the assessment conducted. Also, a suggestion from Hon. Flores was raised that kaingin making of IPs in which it is a traditional practices should be allowed.

A closing remarks from Hon. Reynaldo D. Rodriguez, Municipal IPMR of San Vicente, states a thank you message to the participants as well as to the visitors, even though all other issues and concerns have not been discussed there is a clarification for everyone as to what the rights of IPs are and do's and don'ts inside the Protected Area.

The activity was attended and participated by eighteen (18) females and seventeen (17) males, thus it will be included on the target activity for meetings attended.



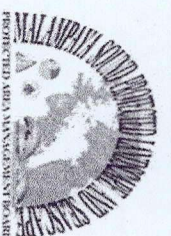
