

BOUNDARIES IN RASA ISLAND WILDLIFE SANCTUARY

Please be informed that the PAMO-RIWS personnel conducted Mangrove Assessment Activity in Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary from May to June 2022. The methodology used in the conduct of the assessment was in accordance with the BMB Technical Bulletin Nos. 2017-05 and 2019-04. Currently, data analysis and report writing is still on going. Final report with maps and documentations will be submitted once completed.

For the delineation of boundaries, Installation of markers/buoys in the 17 corners boundary of Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary will be conducted in the following quarter. TOR for the installation was already posted and currently waiting the signing of MOA. Final report with complete documentation will be submitted when the target is already conducted and accomplished.

For the maintenance of PAMO building and Birdwatch in Rasa Island Wildlife Sanctuary, the TOR was already and posted in Philgeps. Final report with map and documentation will be submitted when the target is already conducted and accomplished.
