Please be informed that the undersigned staff of Mt. Mantalingahan Protected Landscape (MMPL) Protected Area Management Office (PAMO) conducted Dalaw Turo and Dialogue with IP community at Bintat Karis Iskula't Palawan, Barangay Iraan, Rizal, Palawan on June 20, 2022 and at Kelwi Village-School, Barangay Saraza, Brooke's Point, Palawan from June 22 to 24, 2022.

MMPL PAMO preferred to celebrate the 13<sup>th</sup> anniversary of MMPL by conducting the above subject at selected schools within the protected area to reach out the academic institutions within the protected area. The activity aimed to impart knowledge, strengthen the appreciation of IP children and sense of ownership of MMPL by IP leaders and community members.

The team who facilitated the activity was composed of four (4) staff from MMPL PAMO and two (2) staff from Conservation International. They were as follow:

The celebration for the 13<sup>th</sup> anniversary of MMPL was divided into two activities, the dialogue with IP leaders and the Dalaw turo. The dialogue with IP leaders and community members was conducted in the morning from 8:00 AM to 12:00 AM. Though it was purposely conducted for IP leaders, it was also attended by other IP men and women, teachers and several IP children. MMPL profile and value was introduced to the audiences/participants before the dialogue. The Dalaw turo for IP children was conducted in the afternoon from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Illegal selling ancestral land by IPs to non-IPs in the area.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The staff of MMPL elaborated that PD 705 and ENIPAS forbids selling of land within areas classified as timberland/forest land and especially if inside a protected area.</li> <li>• MMPL staff informed a solved incident of land selling inside the protected area at Barangay Iraan, Rizal. The concern parcel of land was sold to a lowlander by an IP with motorcycle as payment. MMPL PAMO in collaboration with LGU Iraan intervened and repealed the illegal transfer of the portion of ancestral land. The motorcycle was returned to the lowlander while the area was brought back to the IP.</li> <li>• They also highlighted the importance of the ancestral land and explained that it belongs to the IPs/ICCs and should stay that way to preserve their culture and conserve the remaining forest and biodiversity of MMPL.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Possibility of mining application</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• One IP community member asked about what can they do if a mining company planned to mine their ancestral land.</li> <li>• The PAMO staff stated that the rights of the IPs/ICCs over their ancestral land is recognized by the government thru RA 8371 or the Indigenous People Rights Act of 1997 or the IPRA law. Any application including mining should undergo the Free Informed Prior Consent (FPIC) whereas thru the facilitation and assistance of National Commission for Indigenous People (NCIP), the IPs/ICCs are consulted. MMPL staff noted that related project will never continue without the FPIC, hence, the IPs/ICCs have the power to accept or declined projects such as mining in their area.</li> <li>• MMPL PAMO staff also encourage the IPs/ICCs to practice their rights to decide in accordance IPRA and collaborate with the MMPL PAMO and PAMB in the protection and conservation of MMPL.</li> </ul>

Film showing	The team showed an environmental animated movie entitled "The Bee Movie" which tells a story about a bee named Barry who wanted to find his purpose in his hive. He ventured outside the hive and found out that honeys




	are being taken from other bee hives by humans without consent and even enslave bees to make honey. These led to work stoppage of gathering nectar and pollination by bees which then led to the near loss of earth vegetation.
Assessment re: watched film	<p>The team conducted question and answer to assess what students have learned from the movie.</p> <p>Important Questions and responses from students:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. What are the important characteristics of bees? <b>Student's answer:</b> Bees are hardworking, Bees work with unity, Bees are smart and Bees are pollinators.</li> <li>2. What are the bad things done by humans? <b>Student's answer:</b> Humans take natural resources for granted, most of them do not care about other lifeforms and mostly use technology only for their advantage.</li> <li>3. What lesson have you learned from the movie? <b>Student's answer:</b> Consumption and preservation/conservation must be balanced; all lifeforms are important and everything is connected.</li> </ol>
Environmental game	<p><b>Environmental Puzzle:</b> The team divided the students into three (3) team and provided different puzzle set to complete. Those who have completed the puzzle first won.</p> <p>The puzzle are images of wildlife.</p>


In particular, the team distributed 128 school kits (*Pencils, Ball pens, Crayons, Papers, notebooks and plastic envelops*) to IP students at Kelwi Elementary School, however, the team did not distribute school kits at Bintat Karis Iskula't Palawan at Barangay Iraan, Rizal, Palawan.



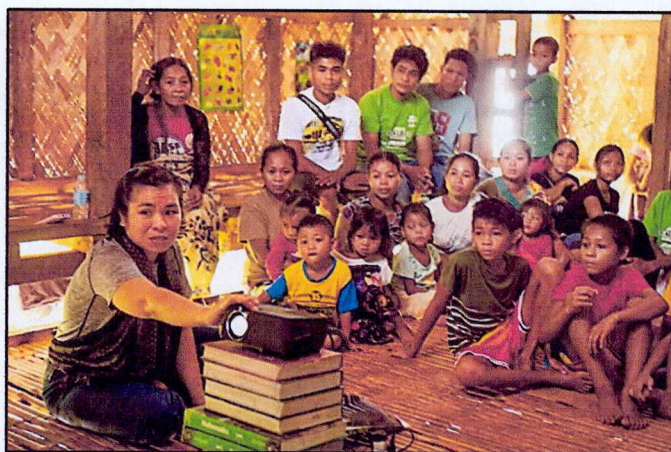
