Submitted is the monthly accomplishment report of CENRO Roxas on ENGP targets within ELCAC Barangays for the month of July, 2022.

Based on the report, a total of 121,656 seedlings/propagules planted in 269 hectares of ENGP plantations located at Brgy. San Isidro and Brgy. Milagrosa, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro. The ENGP plantations contracted by the four (4) People's Organization and forty-five (45) families involved.

For the financial status, a total of Php605,250.00 or 45% of the Php1.345 million allotted budget was already disbursed.

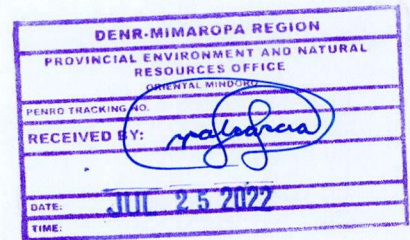
